A fine house, Llawhaden house is one of several historic private residences situated in the parish. Sitting centrally in the small village of Llawhaden, and overlooking the ruins of Llawhaden Castle, this house is steeped in history. Reportedly Oliver Cromwell stayed there just before the battle of Colby Moor in 1645, in which the Roundheads defeated the Royalists. Sadly in May 2000 a fire destroyed most of the house which was mostly destroyed before it had been recorded in drawings and photographs. It is still a listed building. The fire was so extensive that much of the building will involve modern replacement rather than a full refurbishment.

 $Llawhaden\ house\ is\ one\ of\ several\ remaining\ historic\ private\ residences\ located\ in\ the\ parish,\ and\ positioned\ in\ the\ conservation\ area.$

The house, surrounding barns and outbuildings, form an architectonical cluster.

The owners of the property applied for, and were granted Listed Building planning consent for repair and refurbishment of the property which has now lapsed.

The development of this property would return an important landmark to its former glory for the benefit of the locals and visitors alike.
