Ground floor in brief -

The front offers an exterior cupboard space, and enclosed porch leading in to the house.

With an open plan ground floor, offering plenty of space to relax and entertain, the kitchen layout flows from the spacious open plan living and dining room. There is ample space to prepare meals and a handy breakfast bar area, also a large cupboard housing plumbing for a washing machine tucked away, with shelving above.

With the bonus of a separate garden room to the rear, a further family space to enjoy, all year round. The rooms are bright featuring large (double glazed) windows, meaning the home is well lit and feels open, which is enhanced by the neutral decor throughout.

First floor in brief -

Upstairs landing leads to family bathroom, recently updated and smartly presented with attractive feature tiles. There are 3 bedrooms, 2 double sized and one single. Access to partially boarded loft space. Recently updated Worcester boiler, in the airing cupboard serving the heating and hot water.

Outside in brief -

The front enjoys a pleasant outlook over the front garden and green space opposite. The garden room to the rear leads outside to a spacious paved entertaining patio area, the fully enclosed rear garden extends to an additional side garden, well screened with fencing and by established hedging. There are 2 pedestrian gates for ease of access.

The single garage is a short walk away, close by en-bloc and additional on-street parking outside is unrestricted.
