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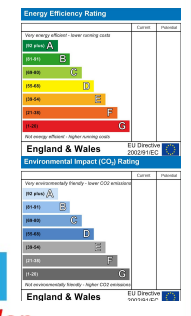

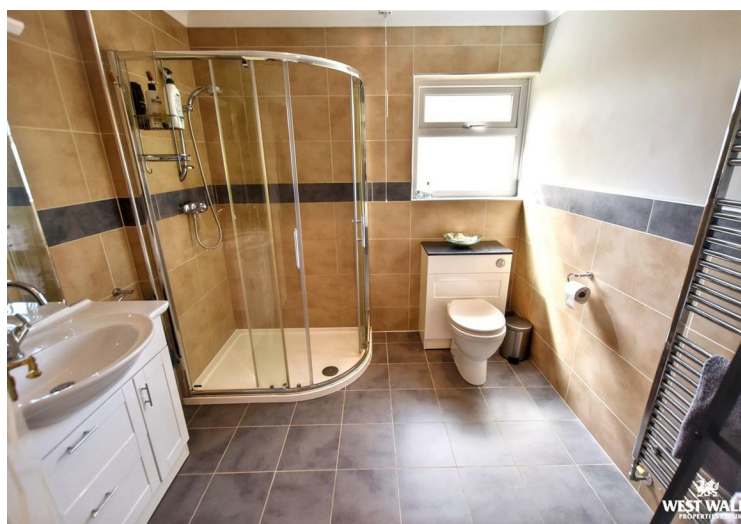

A gated driveway offers off road parking for approximately four cars and access to the double garage.
