

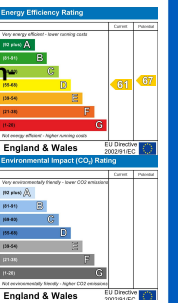

Accommodation comprises : Hallway, lounge with dual aspect panoramic views, l-shaped utility room, shower room, kitchen/diner, sitting room/snug with dual aspect panoramic views, landing good-size bathroom, four bedrooms-three are king-size rooms with the master having an en-suite shower room. Externally the property sits on a plot which measures 0.25 of an acre and borders a small stream, has a large sweeping driveway that leads to a garage and the rear of the property. The majority of the garden is laid to lawn with a vegetable growing area at the back. The property is elevated and has a patio terrace to the front to take in those views!

Burry Port is a small harbour town on the outskirts of Llanelli that offers all local amenities and good transport links. Burry Port is well-known because Amelia Earhart landed as the first woman to fly across the Atlantic Ocean. The Pembrey Burrows dune and wetland system, home to a country park and the Cefn Sidan sands, lie nearby. The harbour has recently been redeveloped and offers a view of the stunning Gower Coastline opposite.

The cooker is run by Gas LPG bottles. Council tax band F. Gentle upward loped path leading to the property entrance. One side of the boundary has a stream running down along side it which takes the water from The Graig. The neighbouring property situated adjacent to the stream has had an infestation of Japanese Knotweed and they have made the vendors aware that they have a treatment plan in place-no Japanese Knotweed has been found on Machlud Yr Haul. For this location, according to Ofcom, the following information is available: Broadband availability—up to Ultrafast (1800 Mbps); Mobile availability— full mobile phone

coverage for all networks. Based on the information currently available to the Coal Authority, a mining report is recommended for this property.
