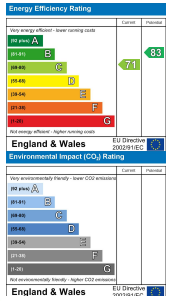

DIRECTIONS

At our office head towards Station Road and at the traffic lights turn right. Stay in the left-hand lane and follow the road to another set of traffic lights which you go straight across. Follow the road until you get to Sandy Roundabout taking the third turning off for Sandy Road and follow the road through Pwll coming into Burry Port. At the roundabout take the second turning off and follow the road passing a petrol station on your left keep on the road and follow it until you get to Pembrey. Just before you get to "St Illys" church on your left there is turning on your right signposted "Mountain Road". Follow the road going up past the physiotherapy center on the left-hand corner. The next turning on your right signposted "Mumbles Head Park". Drive into the estate and bear round to your right, the property is situated on your left, number 26.
