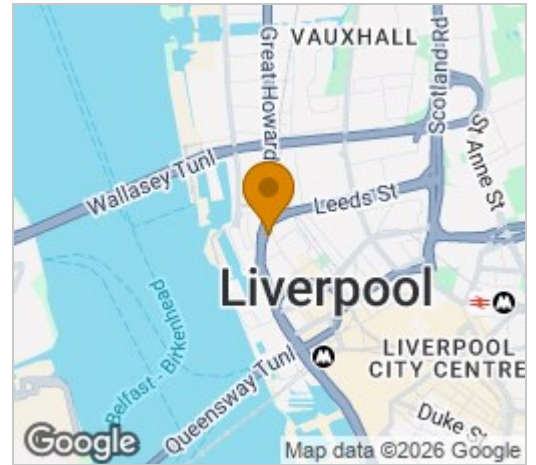

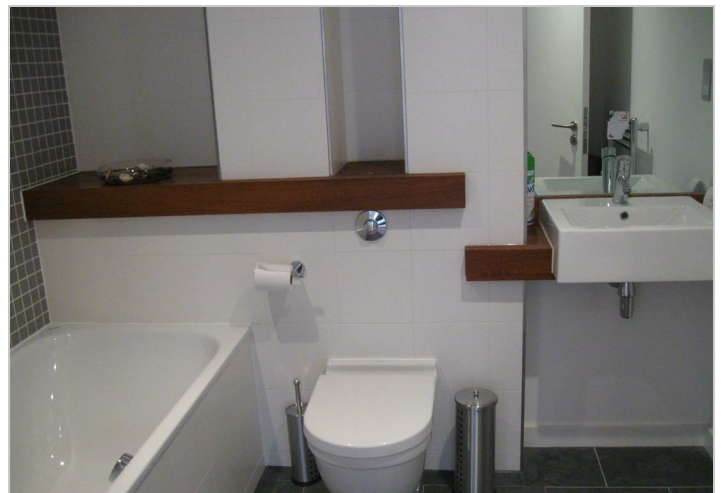
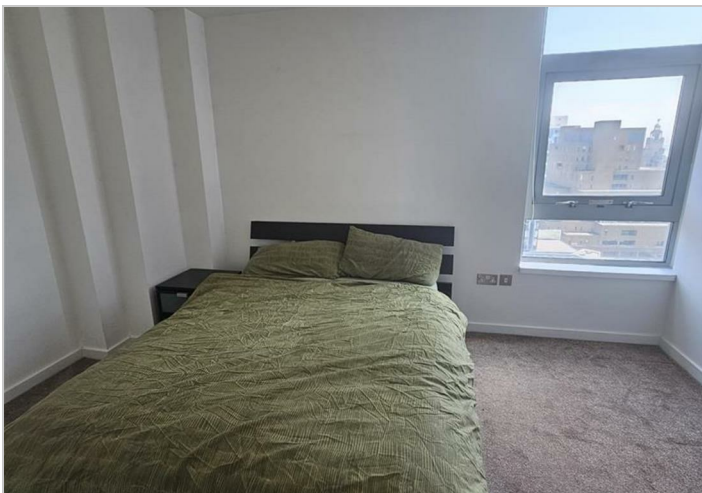
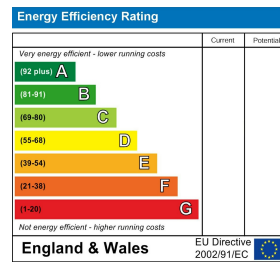
Floor Plan
