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Porch/Utility Area

Access via kitchen or rear door the porch/utility area provides space and plumbing for washing machine.

Kitchen/Dining Room

Kitchen/dining room walls are partially tiled with a mosaic-style pattern along with a cream tiled flooring throughout. The well appointed kitchen provides ample storage in a range of floor and eye level units along with a fitted ceramic sink and space for an oven. Two windows to front aspect overlooking the gardens.

Living Room

Generously sized living room boasting open fireplace with tiled surround, wooden flooring throughout and French doors leading out to the tranquil gardens.

Inner Hallway

Inner hallway to provide access and could be utilised as study area.

Bedroom One

Double bedroom with open fireplace and windows to front and side aspect.

Bedroom Two

Double bedroom with open fireplace and windows to front and side aspect.

Bathroom

Tiled flooring throughout along with a white suite comprising bath with overhead shower, WC and hand wash basin. Frosted window to side aspect.

Outside

The property includes pathway leading from Gloucester Street to the front entrance and expansive gardens surrounding with mature trees bordering the property along with a small patio area suitable for alfresco dining and a separate pedestrian access. There is an expanse of woodland which encourages nature and wildlife to flourish. The whole plot measures 0.38 of an acre.

The market town of Newent sits 8 miles northwest of Gloucester, on the northern edge of the Forest of Dean. Served by three schools, doctors surgery, dentist, sports & leisure centre, excellent motorway links to the M50 & M5 alongside additional local amenities the town lends itself to those looking for an active community.

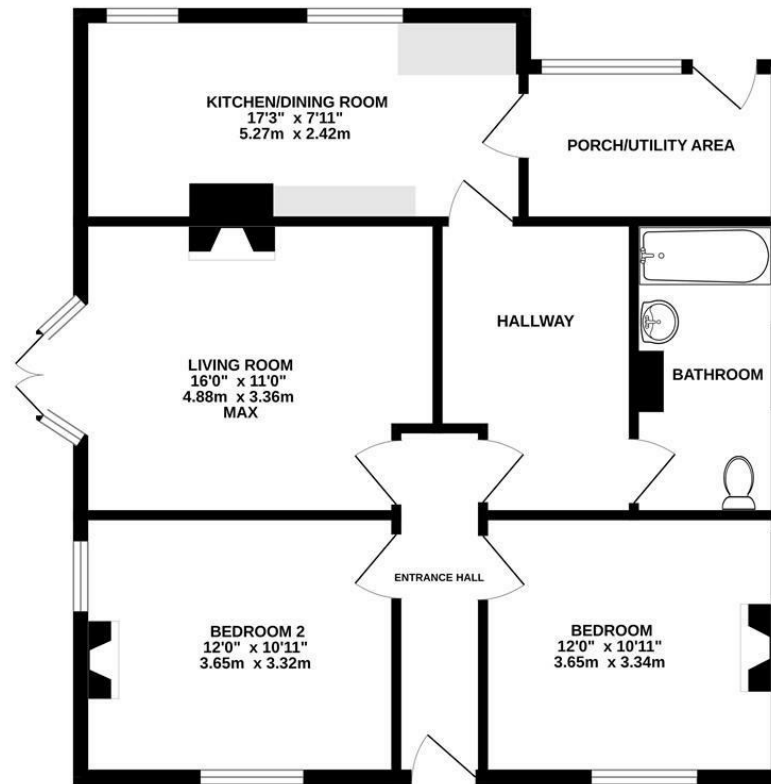

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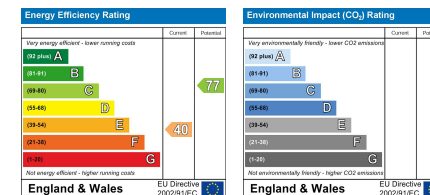
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
