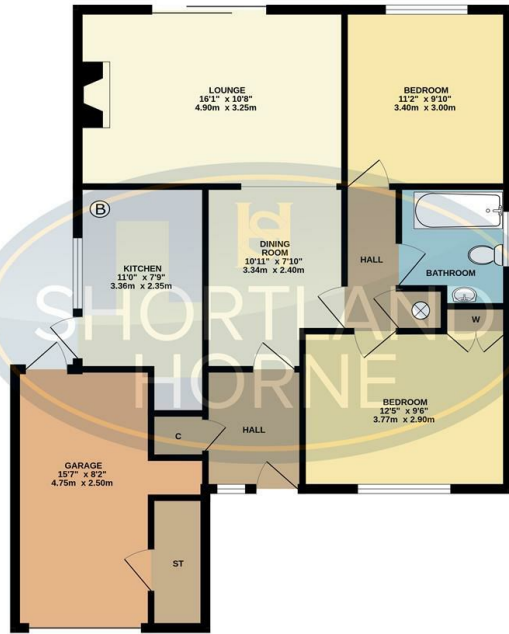


Floor Plan

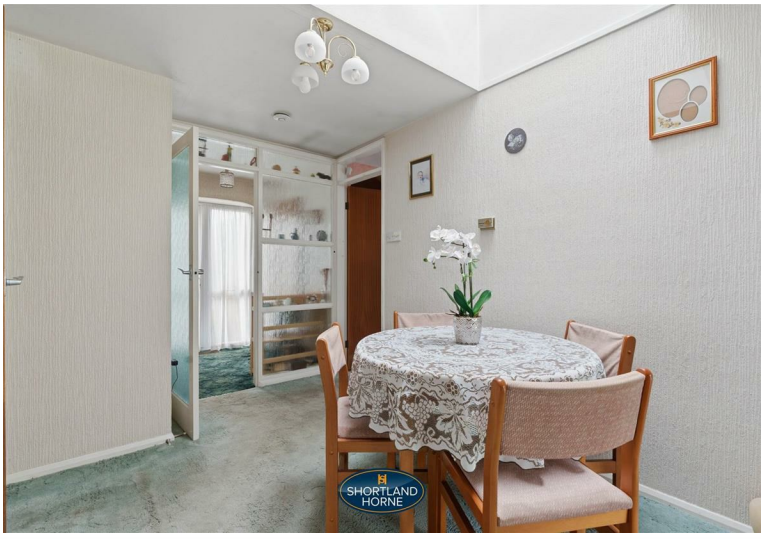
