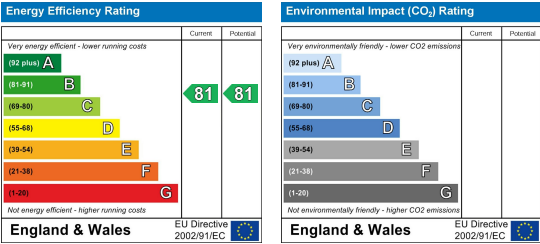
Floor Plan
