

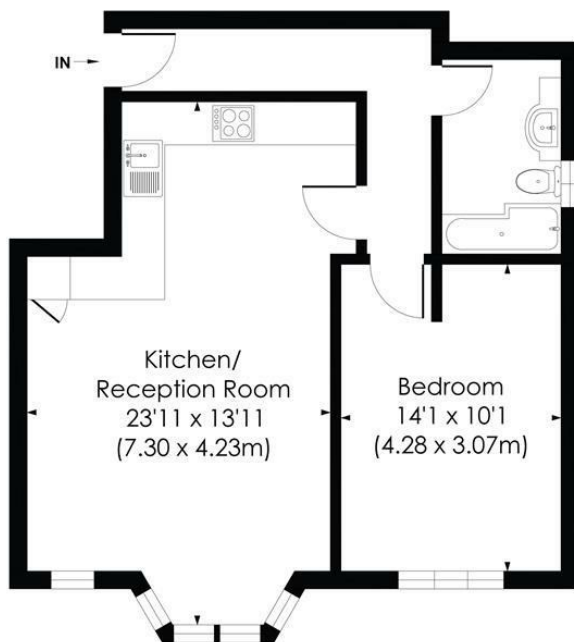

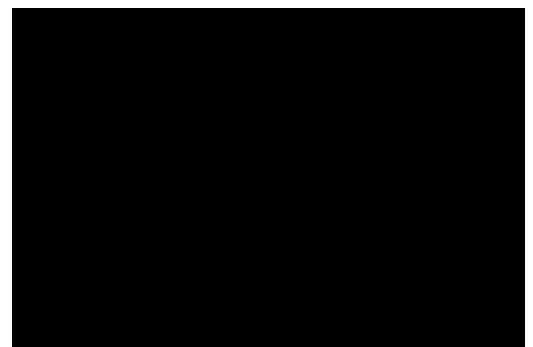


GROUND FLOOR
