A three bedroom character cottage located in the highly desirable village of Ebrington, set back from the road in a quaint terrace of just four cottages. The property features a sitting room with exposed beams and a wood-burning stove, as well as a modern kitchen/breakfast room.

On the first floor, there are three bedrooms and a family bathroom. A particular feature of this cottage is the long rear garden, which offers a number of spaces for gardening and entertaining. A carport and parking complete this lovely home.

EBRINGTON

Ebrington with its picturesque charm is situated on the northern edge of the Cotswold Hills. Known locally as 'Yubberton' it boasts a village green, a village hall and a C of E primary school. The Norman church, St Eadburgha is tucked away in the heart of the village and the Ebrington Arms public house which overlooks the green has won numerous awards. For everyday shopping needs there is Chipping Campden (2.5 miles) and Shipston on Stour (6 miles) and larger shopping, sporting and cultural centres are Stratford-upon Avon (12 miles) and Cheltenham (24 miles). The nearby town of Moreton in Marsh (8 miles) provides a trainline to London Paddington.

ACCOMMODATION

The front door opens into a useful porch, which in turn leads into the sitting room. The sitting room features a wood-burning stove and stairs to the first floor. The kitchen/breakfast room is located at the rear of the house and has a stable door opening into the garden. There is also a ground floor cloakroom.

On the first floor, there are three bedrooms and a family bathroom. Outside, there is a carport and additional parking space. Steps lead up to the front garden, while a path runs round to the rear. The rear garden is terraced and extends to approximately 100 ft, and includes a lovely private decking area overlooking the countryside.

GENERAL INFORMATION

CURRENT ENERGY PERFORMANCE CERTIFICATE RATING: D. A full copy of the EPC is available at the office if required.

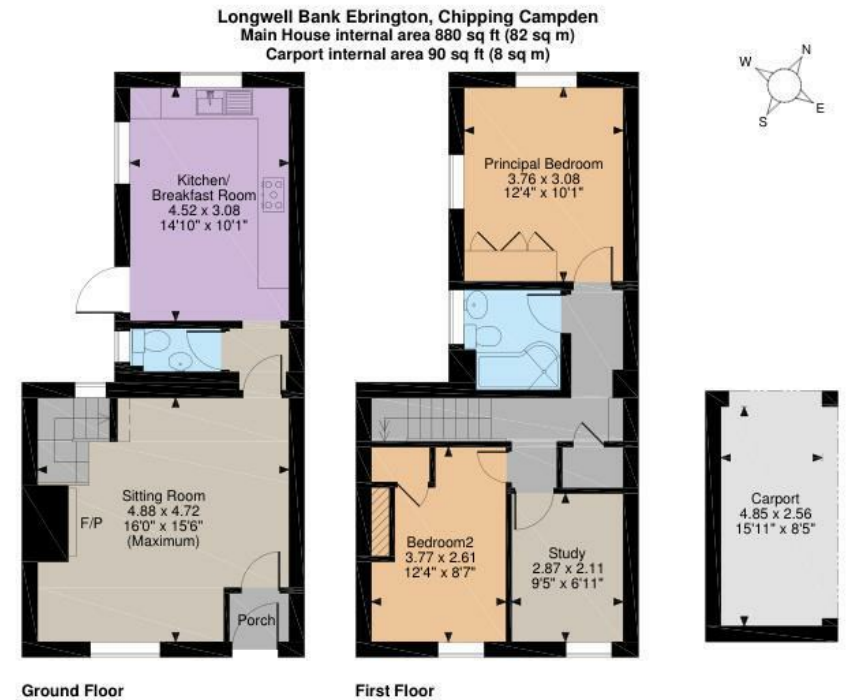
