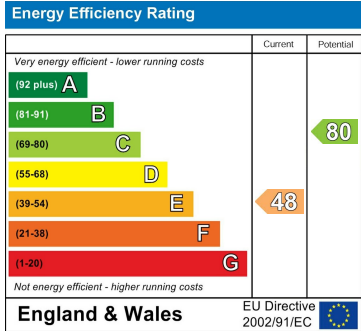
Area Map
