The basement level dug into the foundations offers a self-contained-annex with bedroom/reception room, kitchenette and shower room, along with a handy storage room. The ground floor comprises entrance hallway, modern fitted kitchen/ breakfast room with access to the garden, an open-plan lounge with patio doors leading onto a terrace providing a sun seekers paradise with fabulous views over the reservoir. To the front of the property are two double bedrooms and a bathroom.

The first floor offers a loft conversion providing a spacious bedroom enjoying the most of those amazing views and an en-suite shower room.

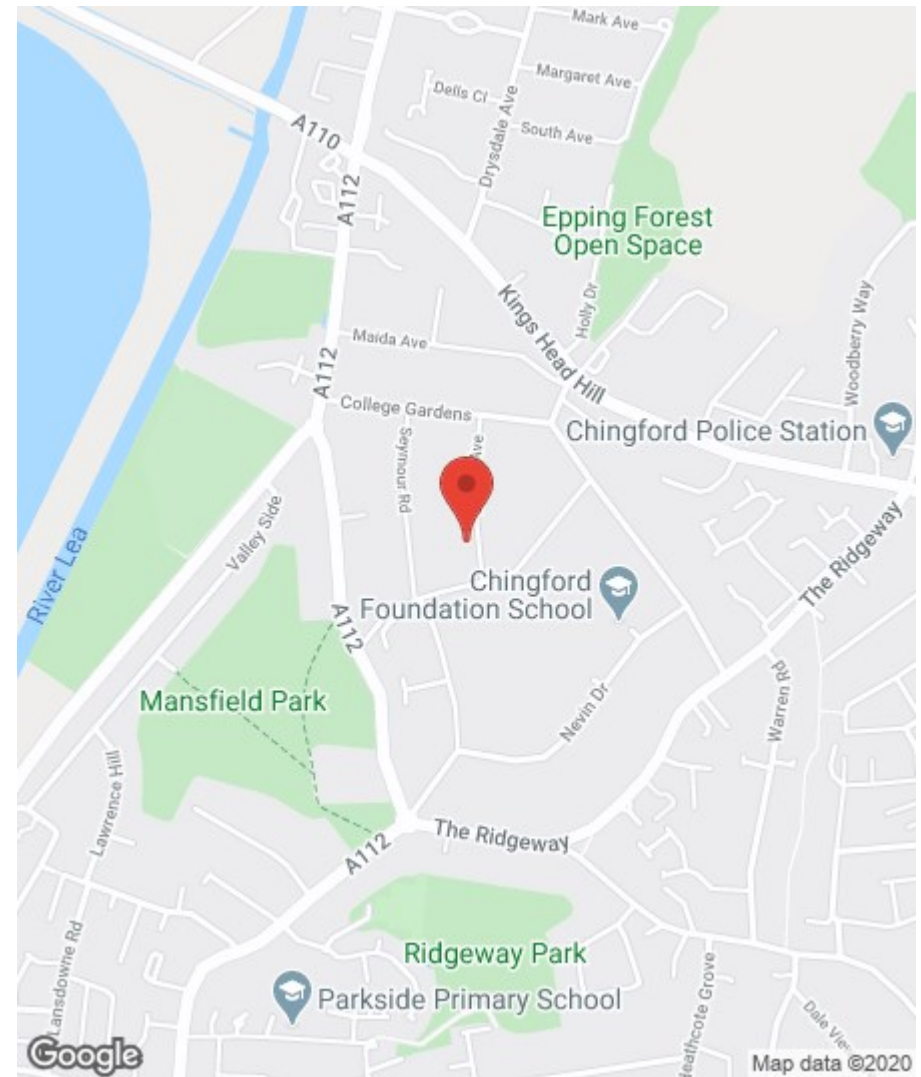
Externally, the property is approached via a block paved driveway offering parking for two vehicles. A sideways leads down to the detached garage and there gate access into the garden. The Westerly facing rear garden has been well maintained and offers 91' approx. of fantastic gardens with a block paved patio with the remainder being laid to lawn with mature borders.

Sunset Avenue, sits within a quiet enclave of North Chingford which borders with West Essex. Chingford Rail Station is a short distance away, there are however numerous bus services via Kings Head Hill that offer direct access in less than 10 minutes. Station Road, being your High Street offers choice for restaurants, offering various cuisine, bars, pubs and local shops, a modern High Street that caters for all tastes and has a bustling nightlife. Also located very close by is Chingford golf course and just beyond you will find various attractions of Epping Forest, with many country pubs, lakes, walking and cycling routes, plus horse riding paths. Epping Forest is steeped in history, as is Chingford, the whole area was once orchards and hunting grounds belonging to King Henry VIII and you will find many references dating back in time.

Located also perfectly for access onto the M25, M11 and A406, with great public transport links, making Chingford a very accessible area all round.
