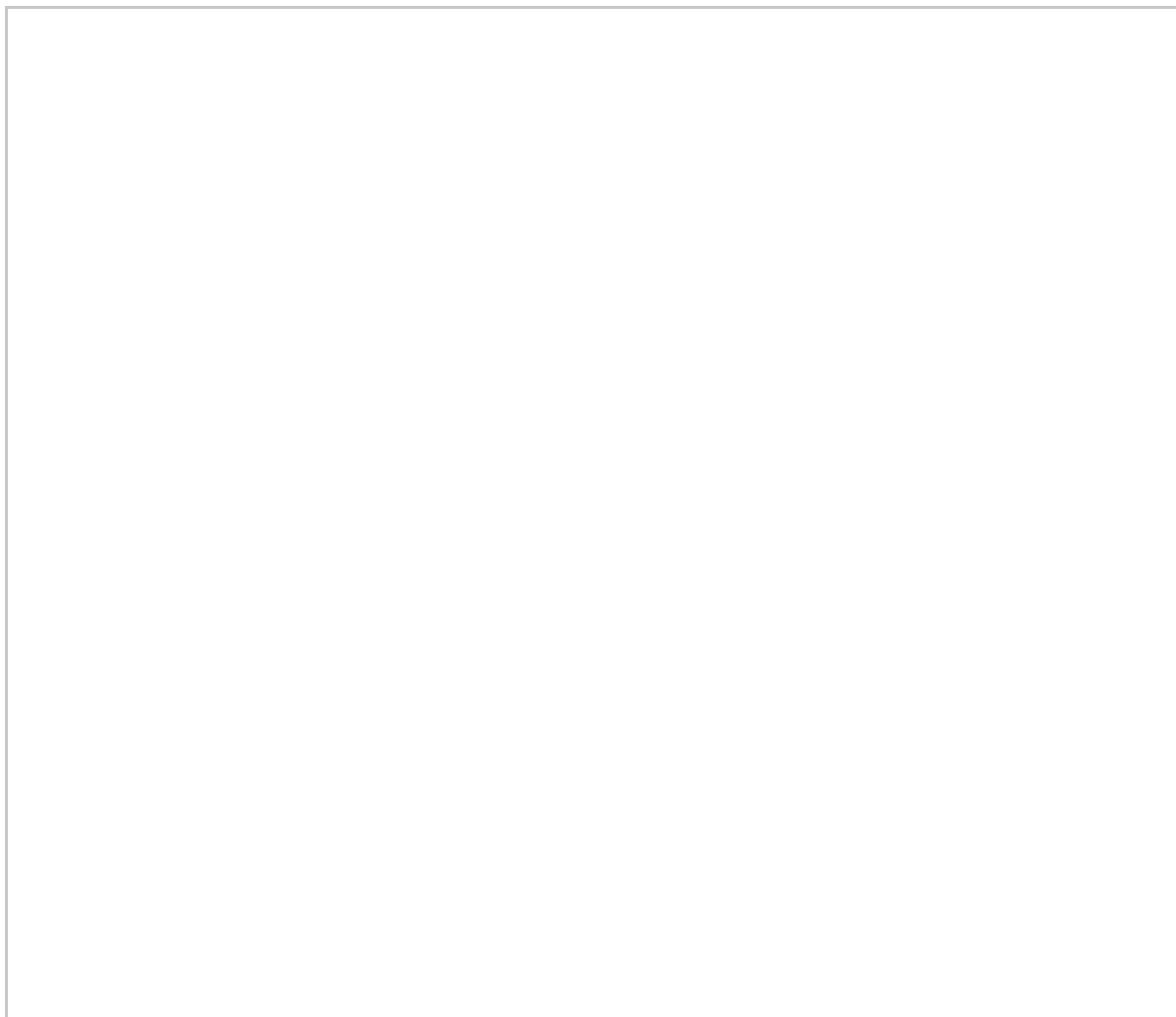







Floor Plan
