AUCTIONEER'S REMARKS

The Barton Farms Limited have farmed in the area for many years, running a sizeable arable operation, covering a wide range of combinable crops. In addition, running approximately 120 hinds on the grassland, producing venison for a number of the major supermarkets. Up until 1999 the farm was home to the "Cathie's Limousin" herd of pedigree Limousin suckler cows, which Earles had the privilege of selling by public auction (some 147-head at that time). The farm has been at the forefront of innovation, with the farm manager, Richard Ward, being for some time a Farmers Weekly "Farmer Focus writer", writing every four weeks for that publication and more recently, in conjunction with New Holland, testing their prototype Dual Stream header, which was matched with the farm's New Holland CX6080 combine or any other mid-range CX, producing some startling results that can be seen on the 'Dual Stream header links' available on our website. The header is being offered for sale in the auction and is comprehensively reported on The Farming Forum, which can also be accessed from our website.

The auctioneers recommend to purchasers the wide range of arable and other machinery from this farm, much of which has been purchased in recent years, has been well maintained and in some cases recently serviced and so is 'ready to work'.

SALE NOTES

LOCATION

The village of Barton on the Heath is located approximately one mile from the A44 Moreton in Marsh to Chipping Norton Road. From the A429 Fosse Way/A44 roundabout to the centre of Moreton in Marsh, proceed towards Chipping Norton. After approximately 2 miles, having passed the National Fire Service Training College and Four Shires Stone on the left, in the hamlet of Kitebrook, turn left towards the village of Barton on the Heath. Pass through the village and Home Farm will be found on the right hand side. "To The Sale" boards will be erected on the day.

From the M40 J11, Banbury and the east, the farm can be approached via the A361 to Chipping Norton, turning right at the roundabout onto the A3400 towards Shipston on Stour. In the village of Long Compton turn left, signposted to Barton on the Heath, and again the farm will be found as indicated above.

CONDITIONS

The sale will be conducted subject to the conditions of sale exhibited on the premises. Purchasers shall be deemed to have full knowledge of these conditions and agree to be bound by them.

PAYMENT

Payment by card is preferred. Cheques will only be accepted from customers known to the auctioneers, unless prior arrangements have been made with our bankers, Barclays Bank PLC.

Under new regulations introduced by UK clearing banks, references are only obtainable by the bank's customers themselves, therefore these will have to be obtained by purchasers, direct from their bank. Without an acceptable banker's reference produced prior to the sale, payment is strictly by card. Payment is due in full at the fall of the hammer and must be made by 3pm on the sale day. Interest will be charged on overdue accounts at 4% over Barclays Bank base rate. The auctioneers reserve the right to hold purchases until cheques are cleared.

BUYER'S PREMIUM

Buyer's premium will be payable on each and every lot, in addition to the hammer price, at a rate of 5% (minimum £1, maximum £1,000 per lot) plus VAT.

SALE TIMES

The sale will commence at 10.30am prompt, with hand tools and estate sundries, followed by farm machinery, implements and tractors, and then 'in situ' items.

REMOVAL/LOADING

All items are at the purchaser's risk at the fall of the hammer and once paid for should be removed within 7 days i.e. by Friday 25th July 2025 at the latest. There will be loading facilities on the day of the sale only.

REFRESHMENTS

REGISTRATION

All attending purchasers will be required to register their names, addresses, telephone numbers and email addresses prior to the sale, in order to obtain a bidding number. This should be clearly displayed to the auctioneer on the fall of the hammer and given to the office staff when settling the accounts.

All persons attending the sale do so entirely at their own risk and neither the vendor nor the auctioneers accept any responsibility for damage or injury howsoever caused. Due to livestock being present on the farm, strictly no dogs are allowed, neither is smoking/vaping in and around the farm buildings. It should be noted that a high voltage power line crosses the northern edge of the sale field. Common sense and extreme care must be taken when loading/manoeuvring underneath these cables and associated poles.
