10'2 x 6'5 (3.10m x 1.96m)

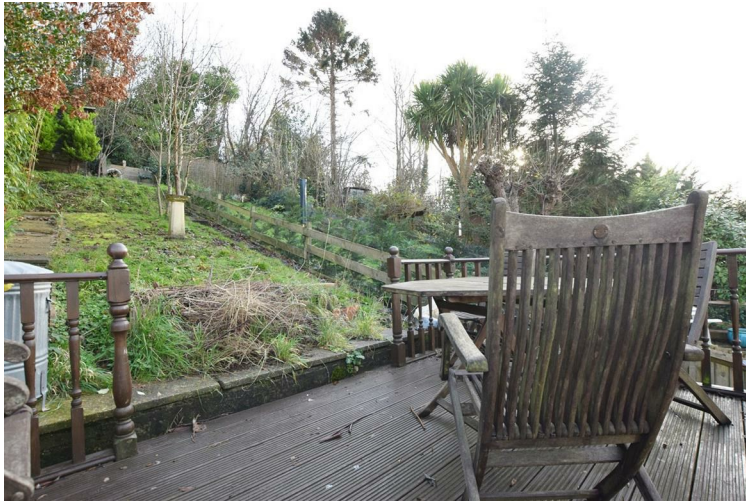
