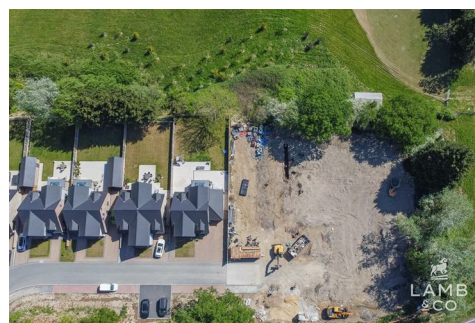

DESCRIPTION

INDICATIVE LAYOUT

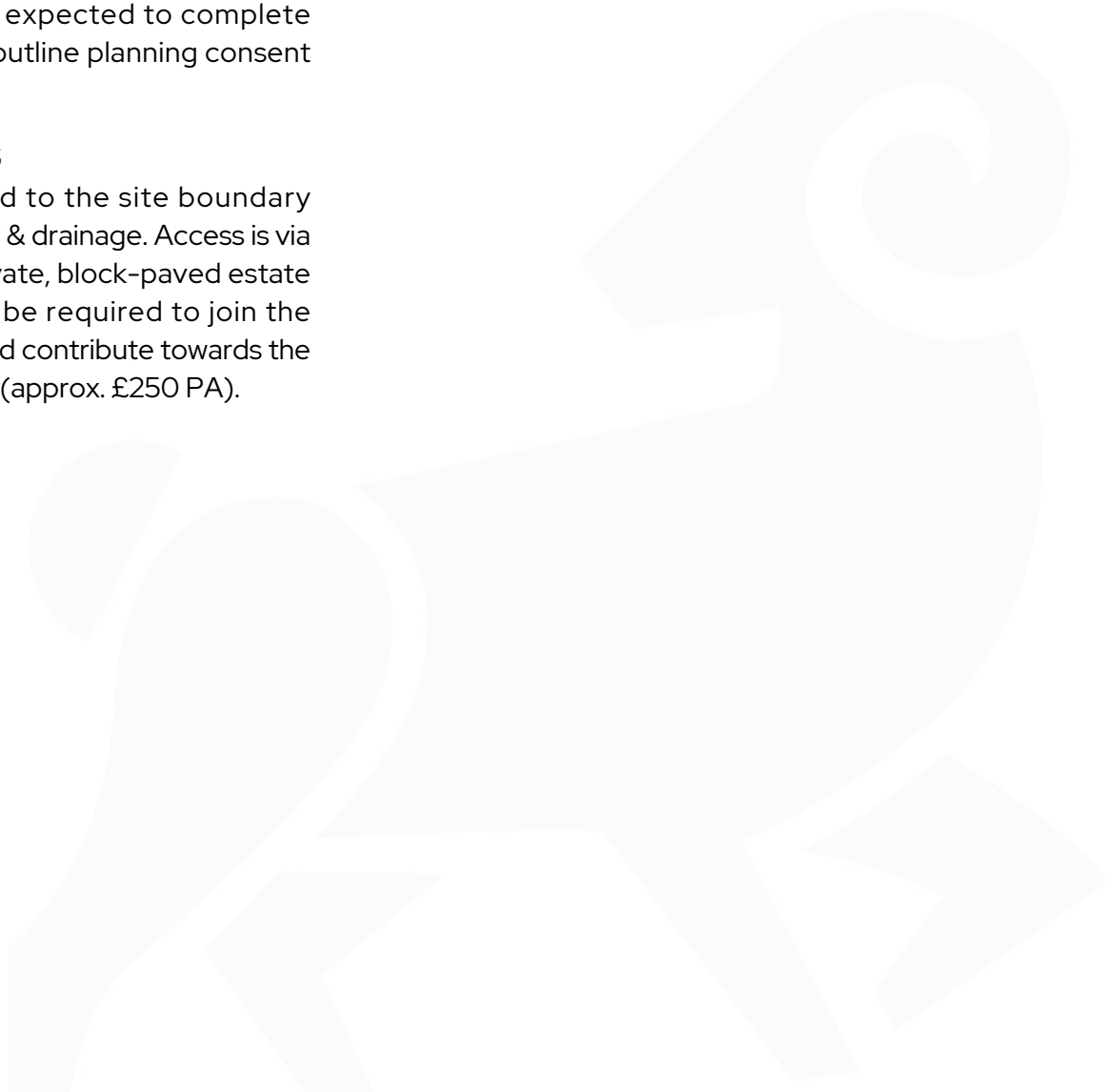

ROAD & SERVICES

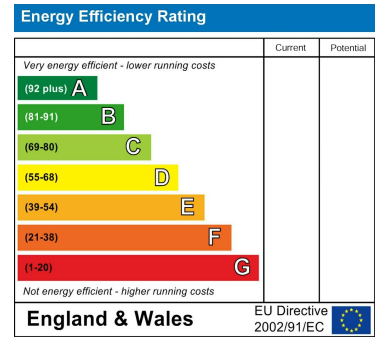

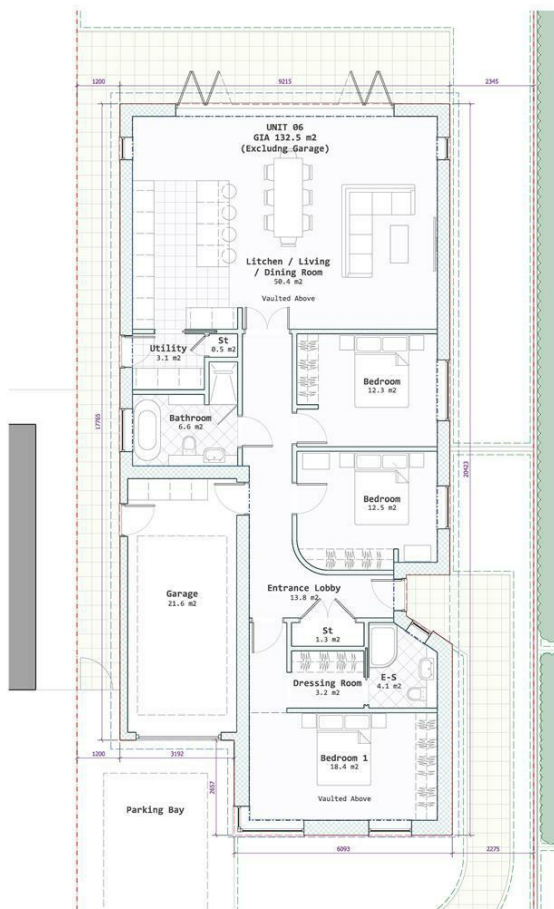

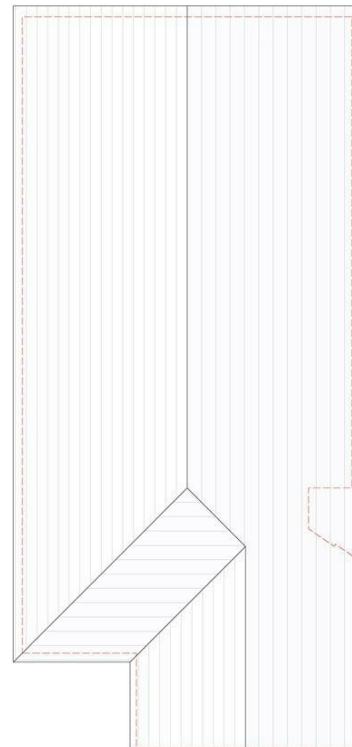
EPC Graphs
