Located in a leafy lane on the edge of Pinhoe and Monkerton, Tithebarn Lane is a great location with superb access to all the local amenities and transport links whilst being off the beaten track. This gives a welcome change to the many new builds in the area, being a new conversion of an old barn, providing modern finishes with plenty of character. The property will be handed over with a 10 year structural warranty, flooring throughout is included (a mix of carpet, vinyl and tiles) and gardens will be turfed. The parking areas will be block paved and gravelled.

This semi-detached barn conversion has open plan living on the ground floor with a good sized and flexible living room, opening into a dining area and kitchen. The kitchen has integrated dishwasher, fridge/freezer, oven and hob and there is also a utility and WC. In addition, and still on the ground floor, is a bedroom with en-suite which gives flexibility. On the first floor are two further double bedrooms, one with en-suite and a family bathroom being well fitted with a white suite.

Outside, the entire plot is level and a garden area provides an ideal space for al-fresco eating. There is also car parking for both properties.

The property is nearing completion and reservations can be made now.








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EAST ELEVATION
