The Property

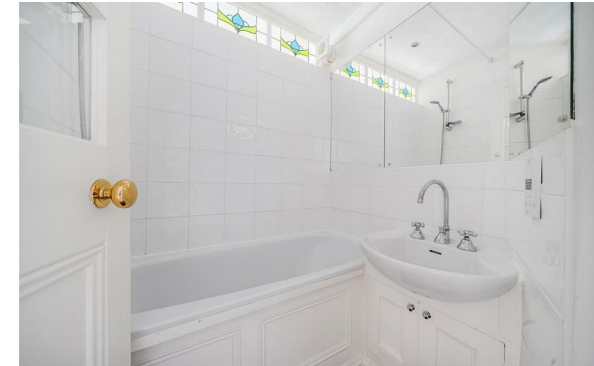

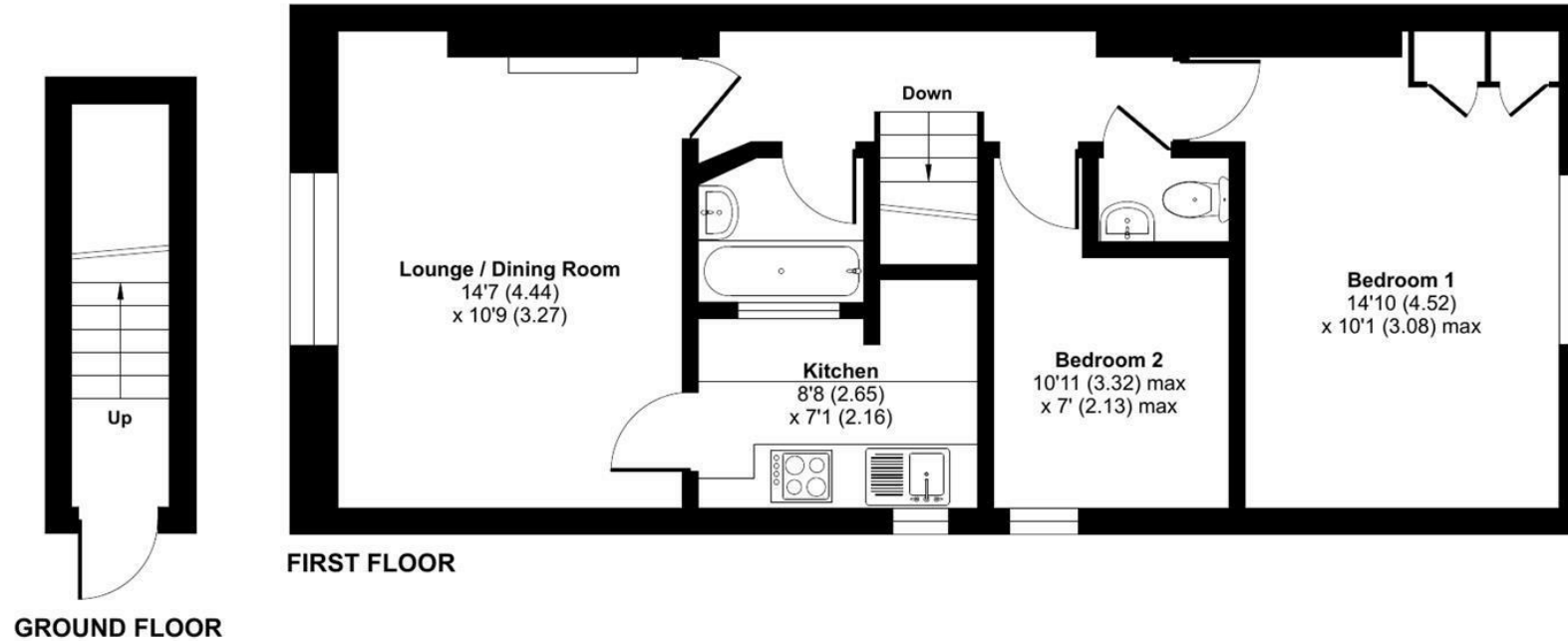
