With over 3700 sq ft of space in the main house, there's a separate newly renovated 2 bedroom cottage, cinema room, gym, swimming pool, tennis court, pool room, outside bar, sauna and a separate office complex and stables. In total Novello House offers circa 9000 sq. ft This really does represent an extremely exciting and unique opportunity just 45 mins drive and 25 minutes by train from the centre of London with Heathrow Airport being only 13 miles away.



Ground Floor

The front door opens to an entrance hall which in turn opens onto a magnificent drawing room with original oak beams, a huge inglenook fireplace and feature spiral staircase. Off the drawing room is a unique dining room with bar area. The kitchen is of a double aspect and affords fantastic views of the garden. Completing the ground floor is a separate utility room, library, utility room, downstairs shower room and substantial living room.

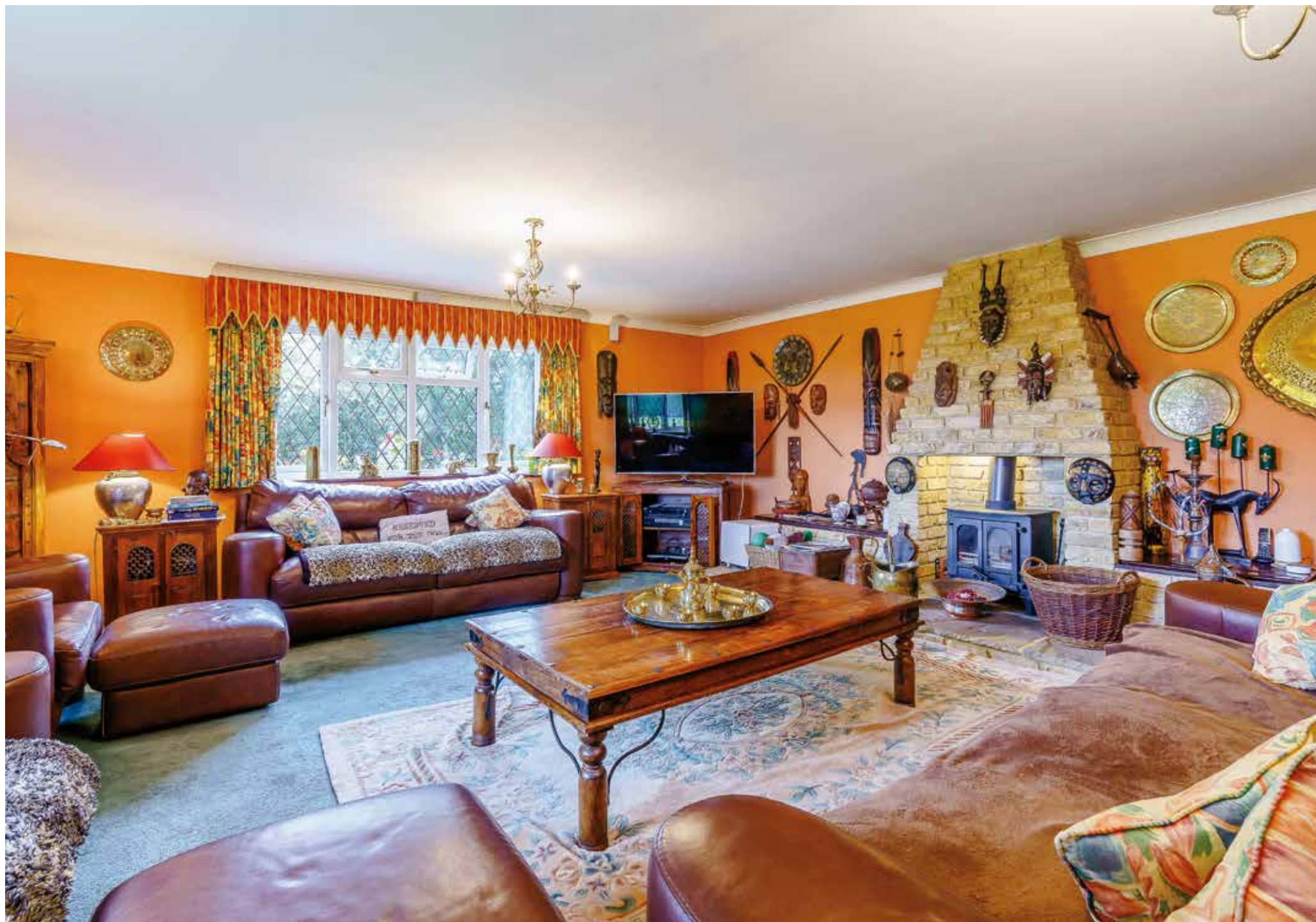

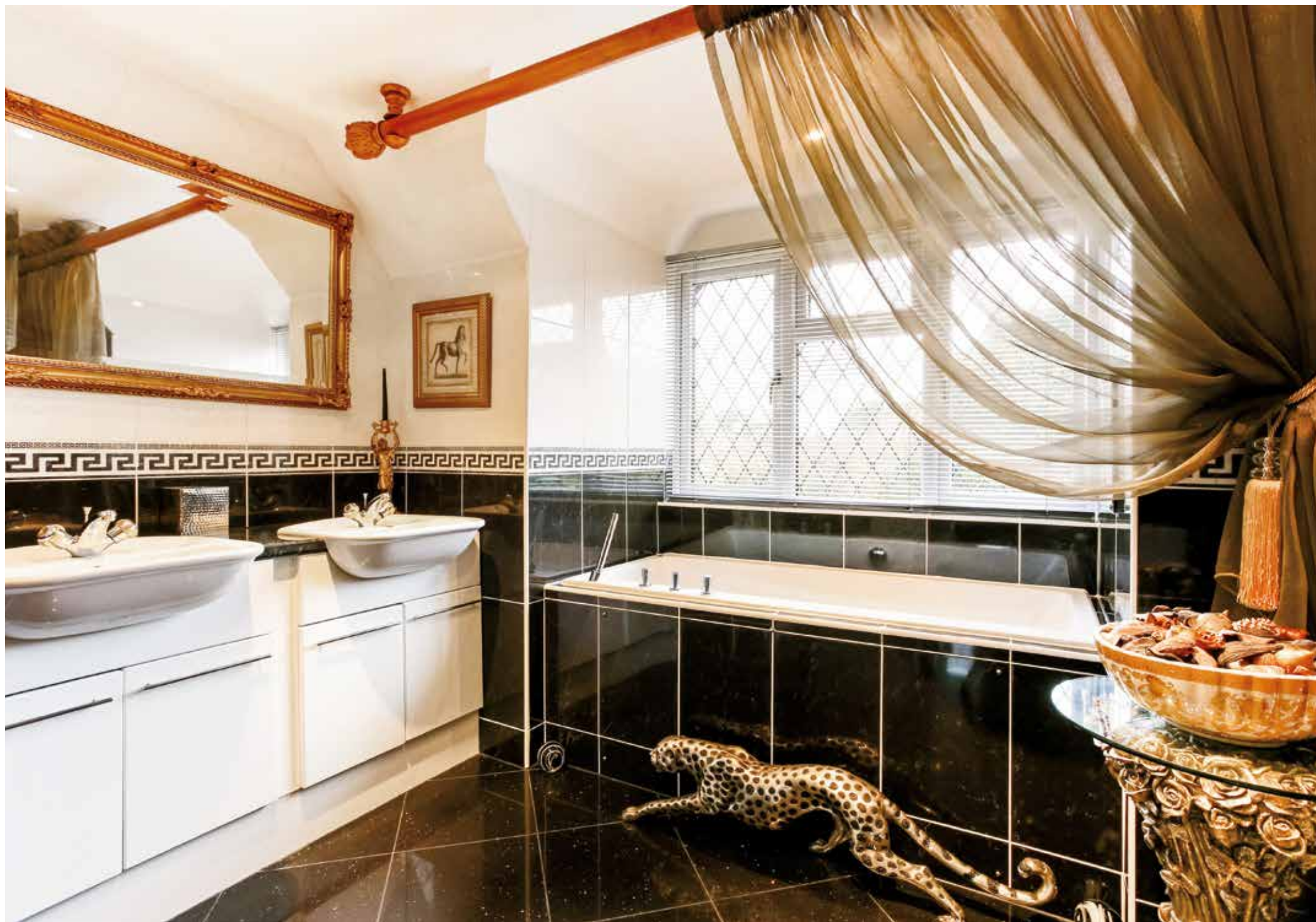




First Floor

Novello House is approached via a York stone carriage driveway. The property sits in extensive grounds of over seven acres, which include areas of beautifully manicured garden and paddock. There is a swimming pool area, with pool house and bar, and a tennis court. Within the grounds are several outbuildings, including a detached two-storey cottage, an office suite that could be converted to residential subject to the usual planning permissions and a building containing a games room, gym and cinema room.







Location

Novello House is situated on a beautiful road in a semi-rural location with access to local amenities in Binfield. More extensive shopping can be found in the nearby towns of Maidenhead, Ascot, Bracknell and Windsor.

There are a wealth of sporting and recreational facilities close by. Wentworth Golf Club with its world-class golf and country club is just 15 minutes away as is Coworth Park which has a beautiful hotel and award-winning spa. Polo is a real part of the area and Guards at Windsor, The Royal Berkshire and some smaller clubs like Fifield and Carlito's are within close proximity as are Ascot and Newbury racecourses. For food lovers, some of the Country's top Michelin starred restaurants can be found in nearby Bray including the Waterside Inn and Fat Duck as well as the French Horn in Sonning. A great gastropub The Shurlock Inn is 5 minutes away and offers fantastic food and a beautiful outdoor area.

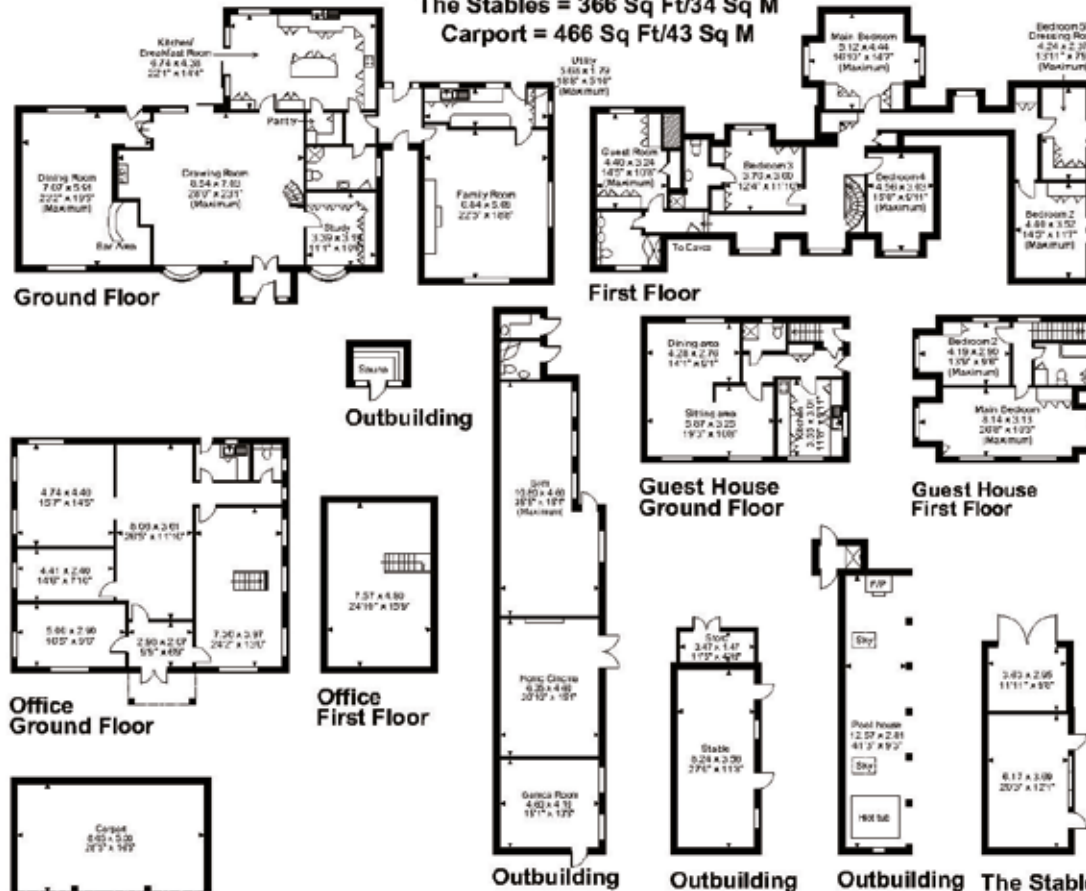
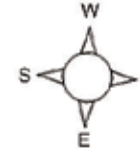
