About the property

An extended three storey Grade II listed house overlooking the village square.

The property, which is larger than first appearances would suggest and is thought to be of Tudor origin, offers good size accommodation along with many exposed timbers & an attractive inglenook fireplace. The ground floor comprises entrance hall with a tiled floor, living room to the front with a fireplace and wood burner, WC & kitchen/diner with door & views over the rear garden. The dining area provides enough space for a decent sized table & chairs and also includes useful built in full height storage cupboards to one wall. The stylish kitchen includes a range of wall and base level cabinets with wood work tops and fitted electric hob and oven. There are 3 bedrooms on the first floor, with the principle enjoying the benefit of an ensuite shower room and the other two having pleasant views over the village square. The 4th bedroom is located on the second floor and includes an impressive beamed vaulted ceiling along with useful study. Offered with NO CHAIN DELAY.

Outside

The south facing rear garden is laid primarily to lawn & enclosed by red brick walls. The garden includes a selection of mature trees and shrubs and a brick patio terrace. There is a timber storage shed to the rear of the garden.











Ground Floor
