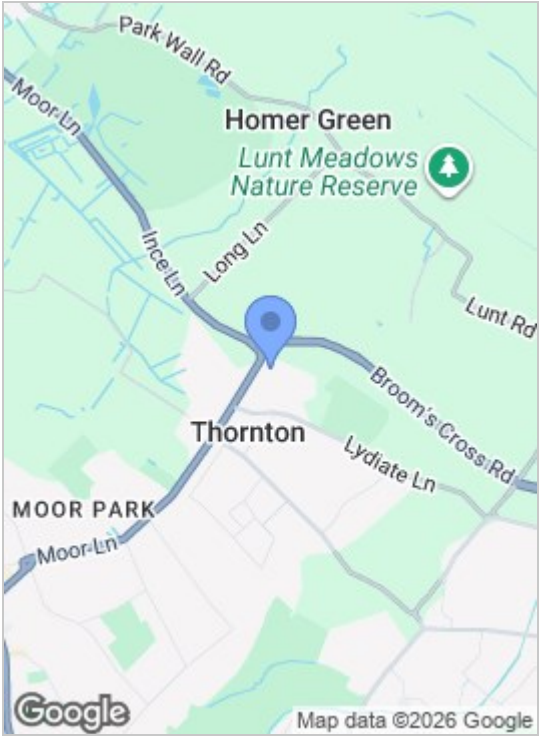

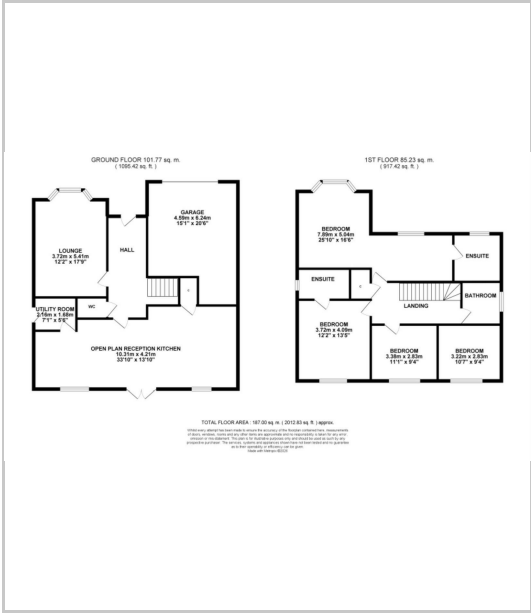

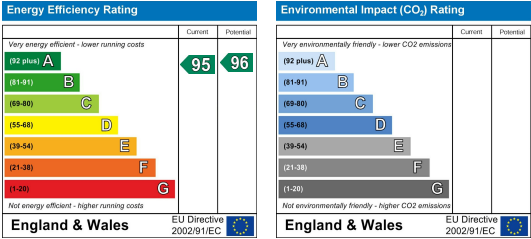
Area Map
