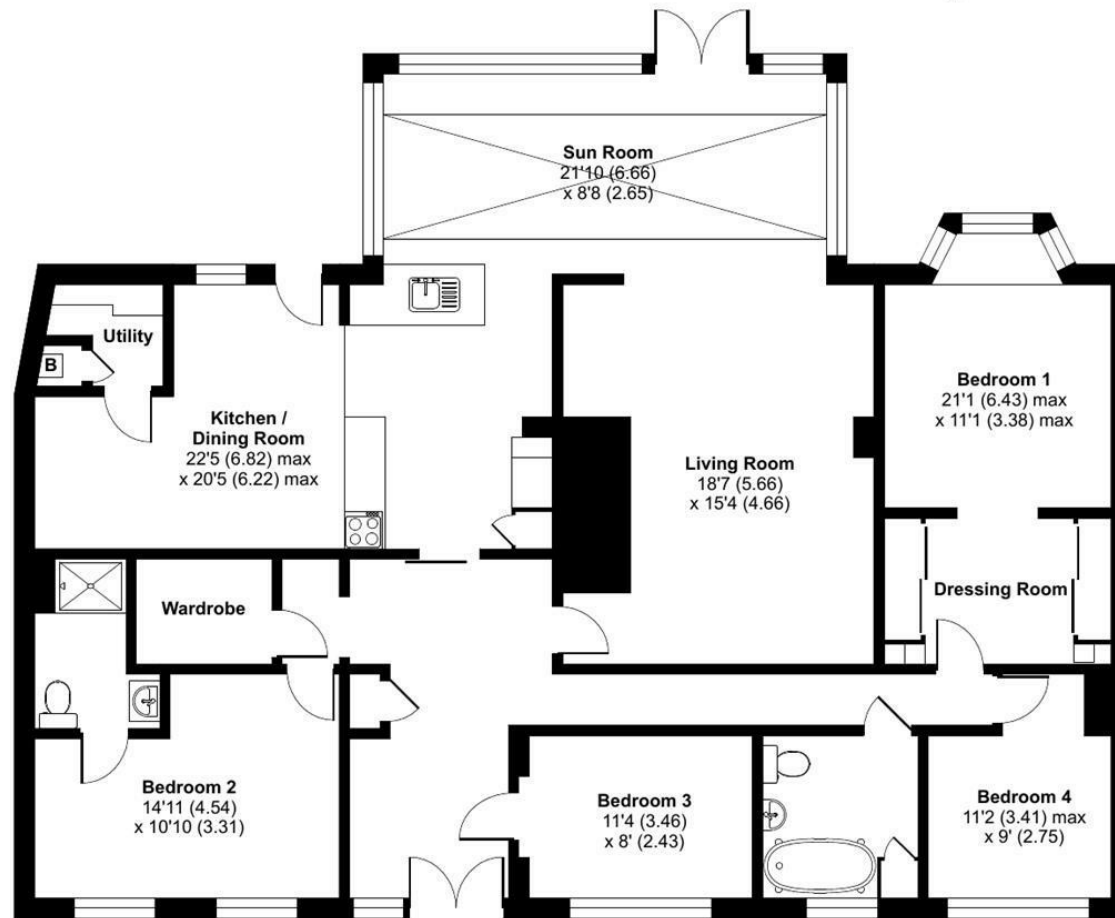




Church Lane, Wexham, Slough, SL3

GROUND FLOOR



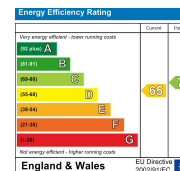
