The enclosed mature garden has a patio, being mostly laid to lawn with various shrubs, bushes and fruit trees.



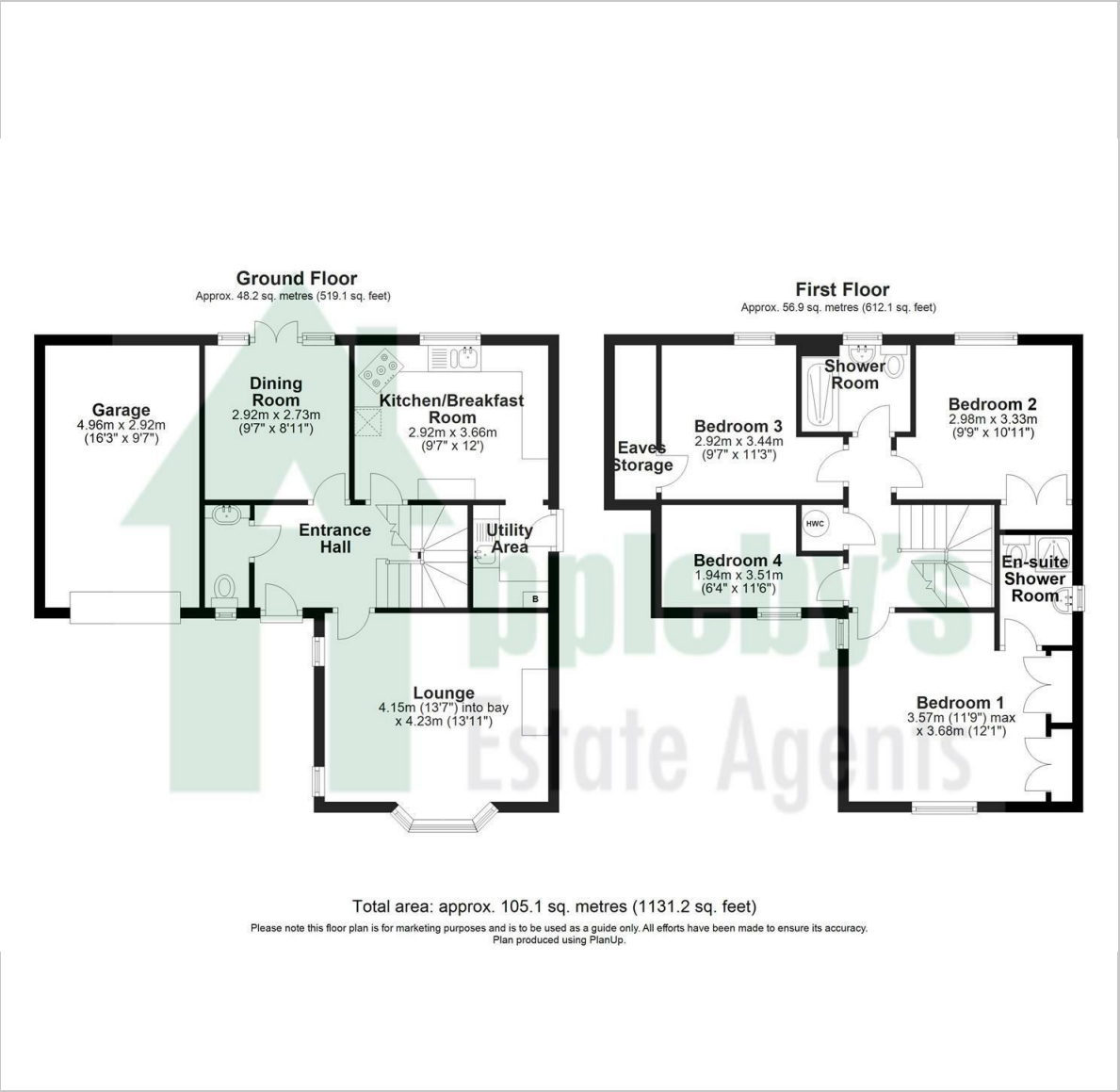

Floor Plan

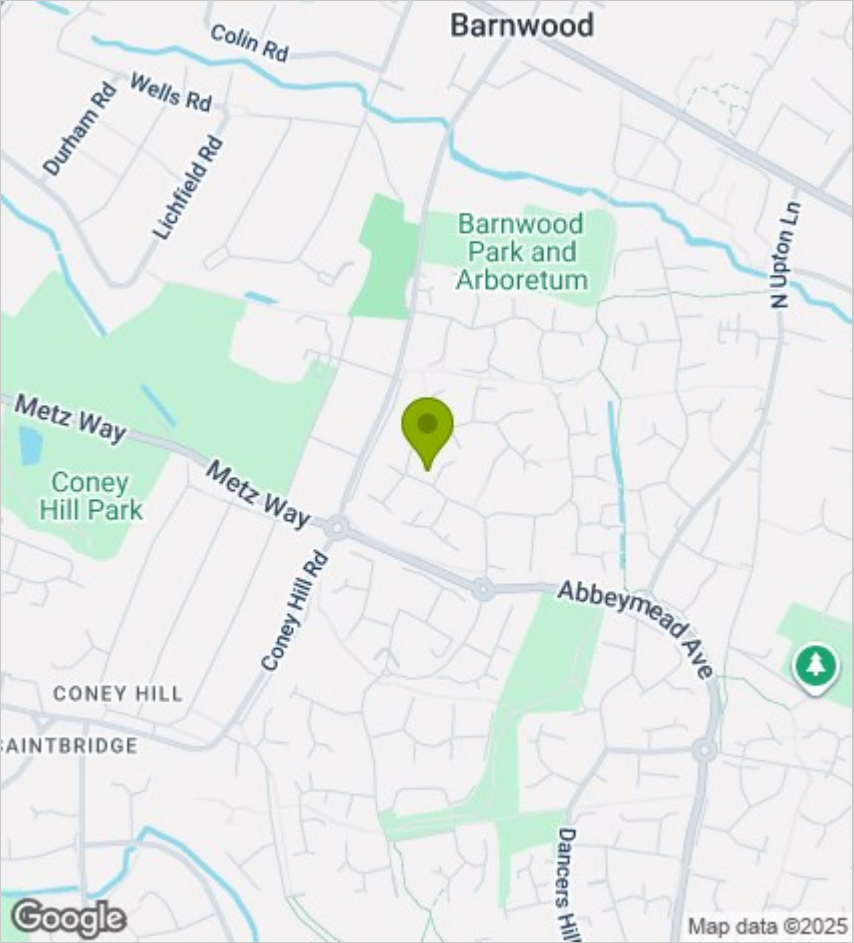
