Conveniently located within walking distance of the town centre, public transport links, and a range of local amenities, this flat offers a fantastic balance of space, value and accessibility.



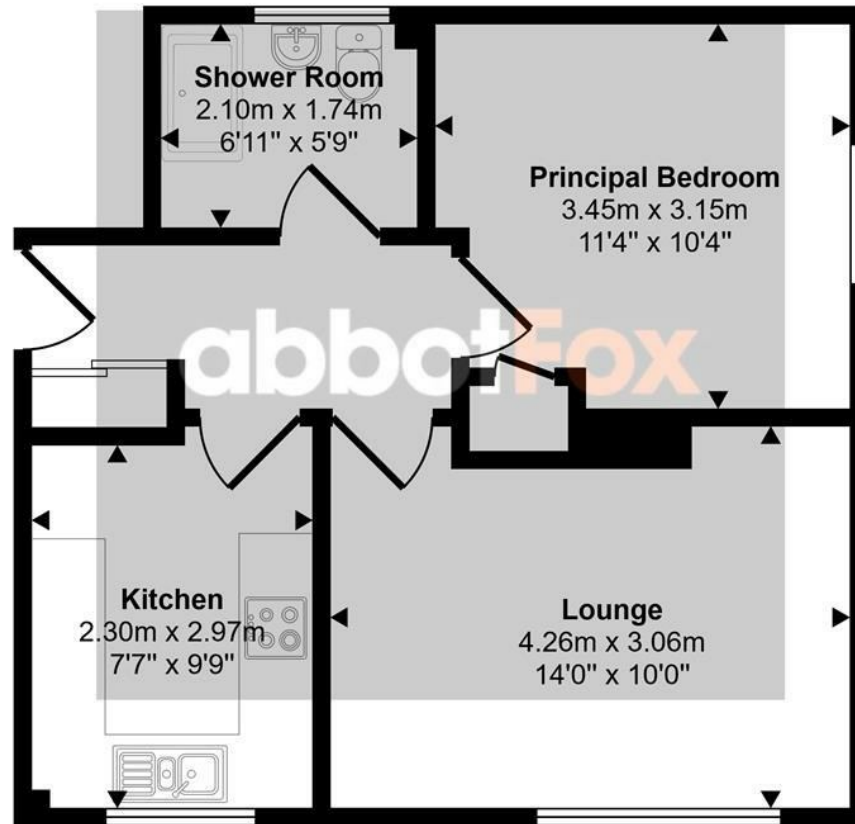
