An internal viewing comes highly recommended to appreciate this home.



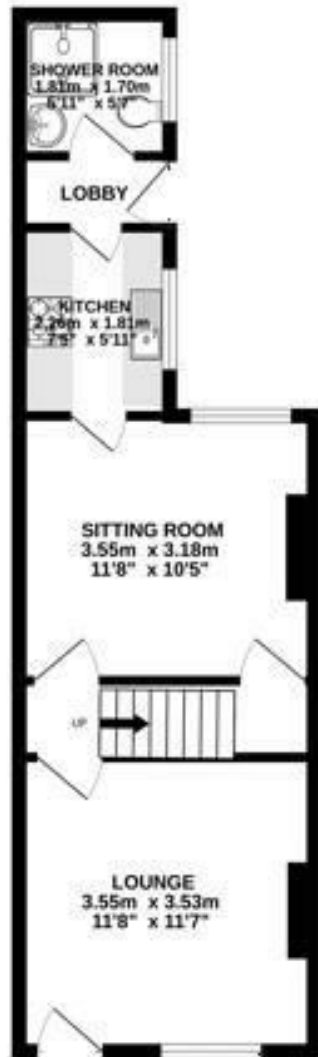
