Offered to the market with no onward chain, this home presents an excellent opportunity for buyers looking to take their first step onto the property ladder. An internal viewing is highly recommended.



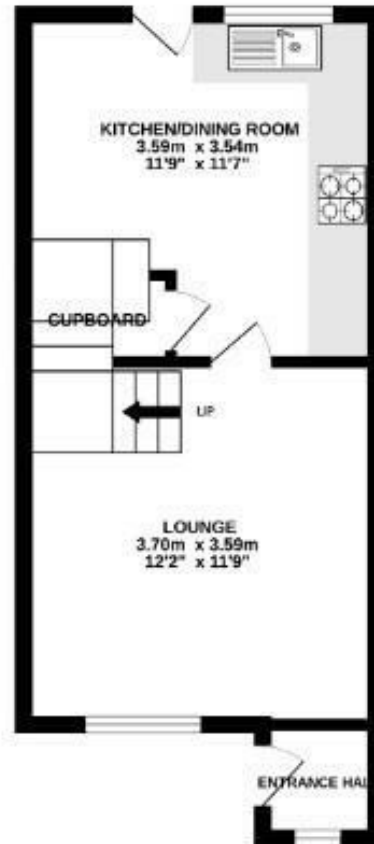
