The kitchen is well appointed and thoughtfully positioned, overlooking the gardens and connecting naturally with the dining room, creating a sociable heart to the home.

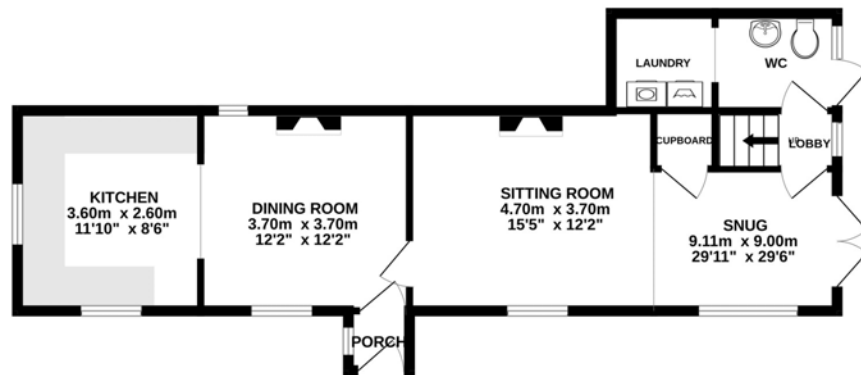

Throughout the house, period features have been retained wherever possible, creating a home that feels authentic rather than preserved; a place where history enhances everyday living rather than dictates it.

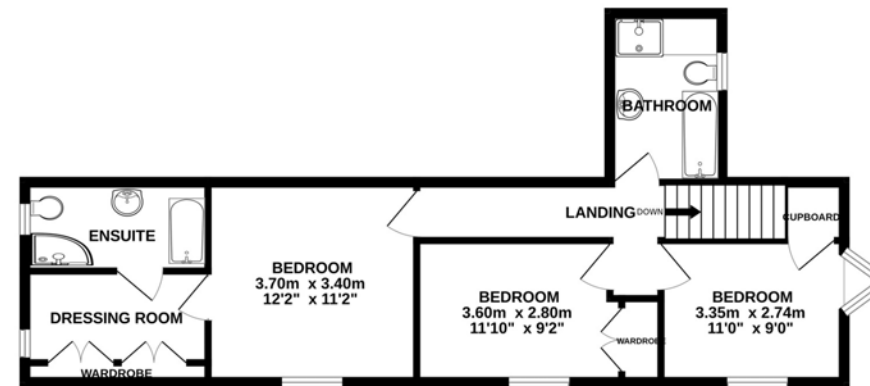




GROUND FLOOR
