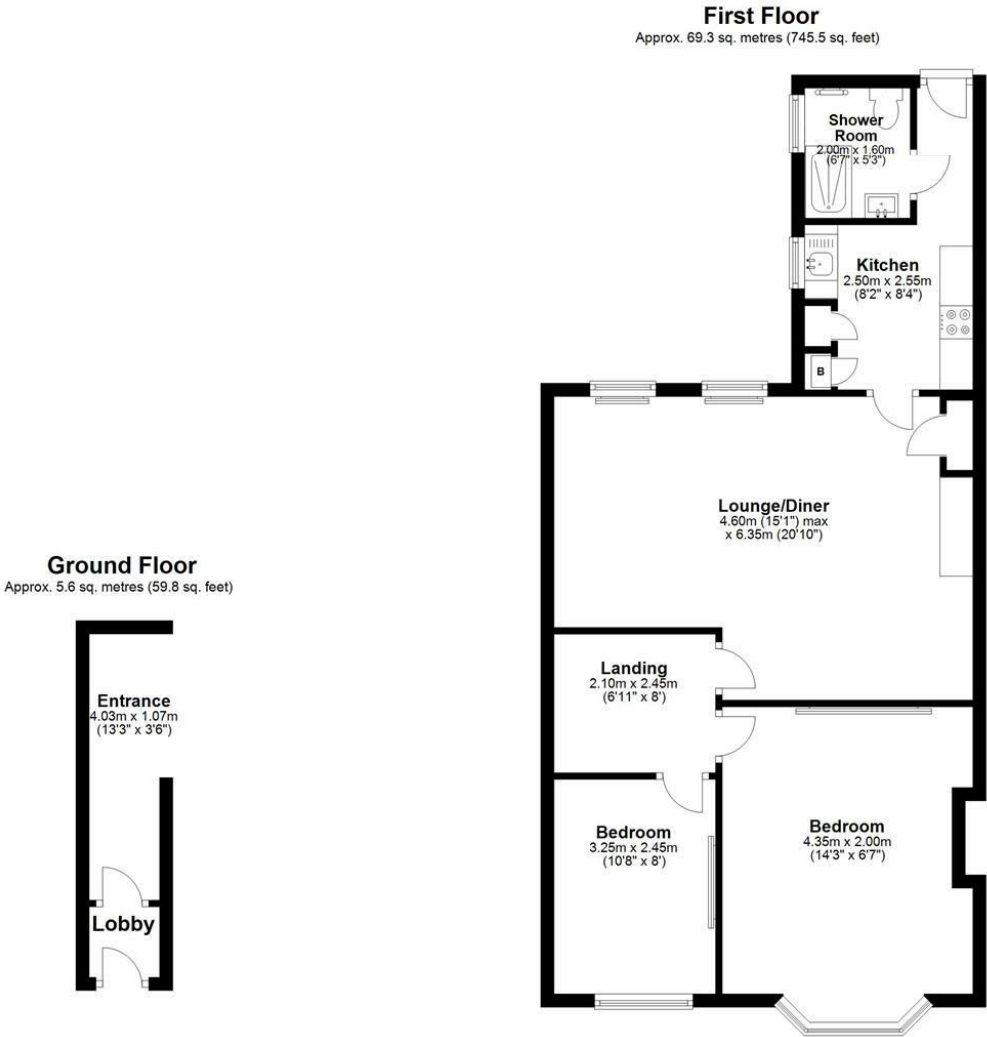

The living area has been opened up to create a luxurious living-dining space, setting it apart from a typical Tyneside flat. Decorated with warm neutrals, the dining area has been painted in a rich terracotta colour giving a sophisticated appearance, while mid-century style furniture contrasts the Victorian features in the room. Rattan lighting complements the Scandi furniture and ceramic Pooky pendant lights create a centrepiece in the dining area.

The kitchen has been beautifully designed, with a skylight illuminating the space, modern terrazzo tiling throughout and sleek green cabinetry. 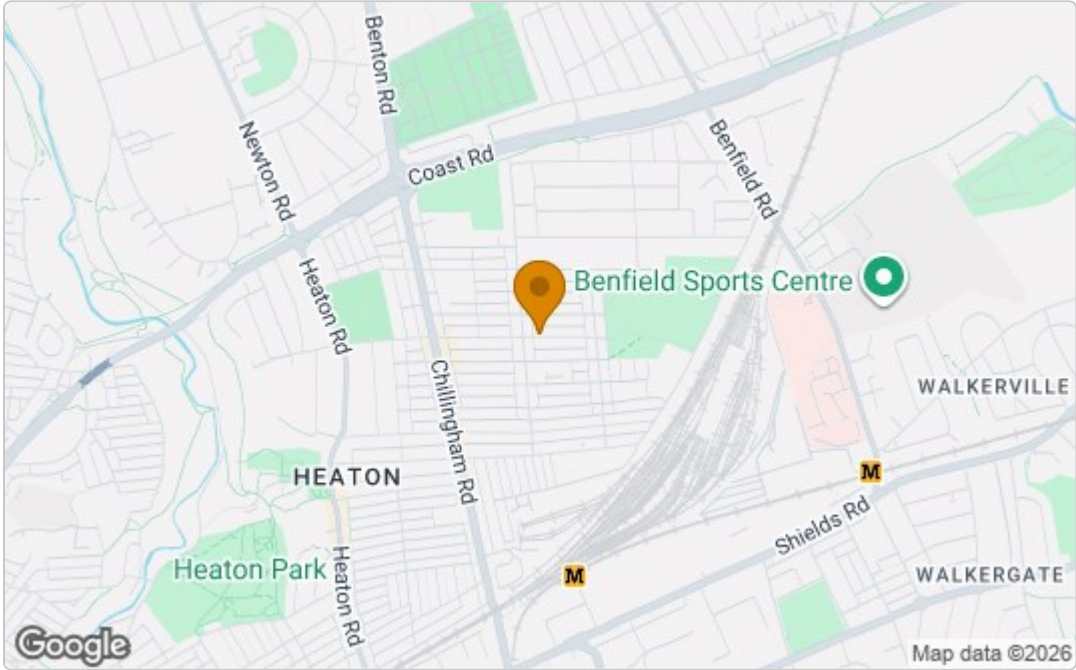

Floor Plan

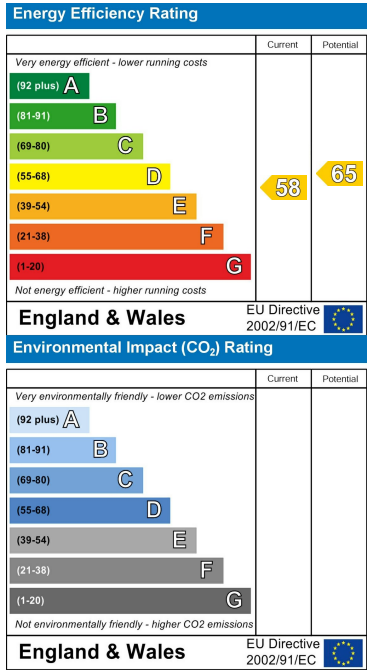
