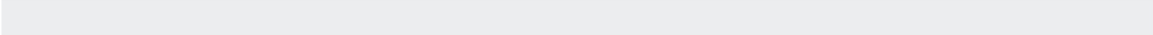

To the rear of the property there is an enclosed courtyard style shared garden.

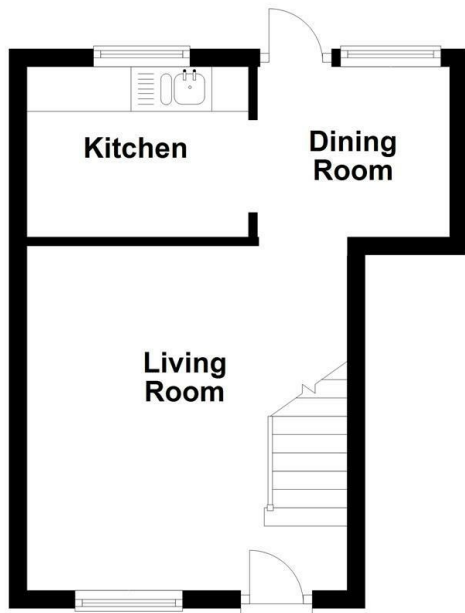
