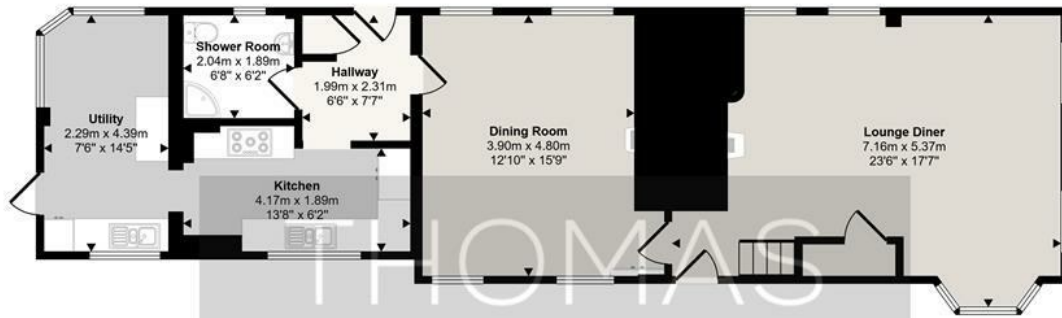

The mature gardens create a wonderful sense of privacy and tranquillity, while the sweeping approach and traditional styling evoke the charm of a quintessential English country cottage.

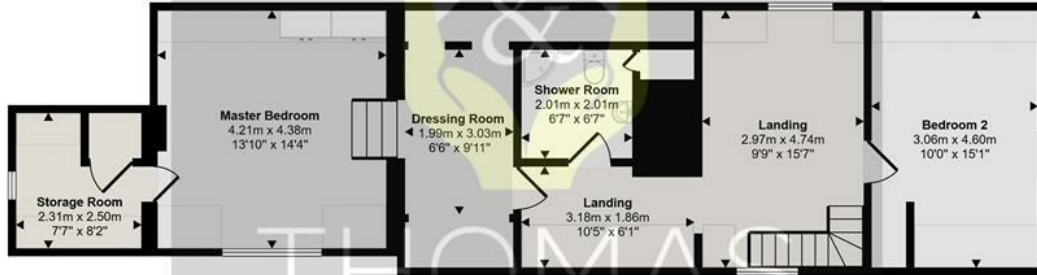

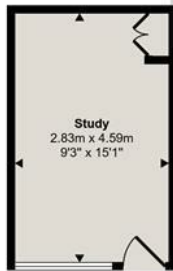
