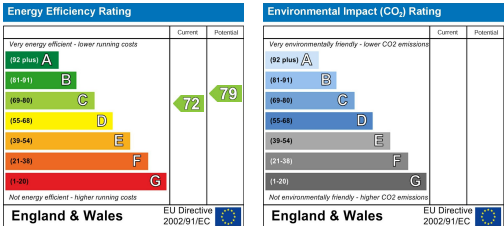
Area Map
