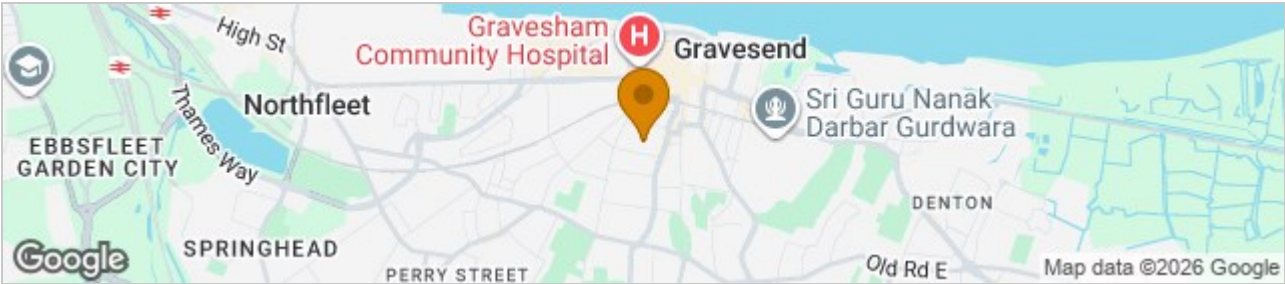

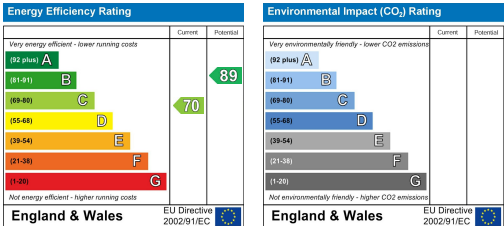
Area Map
