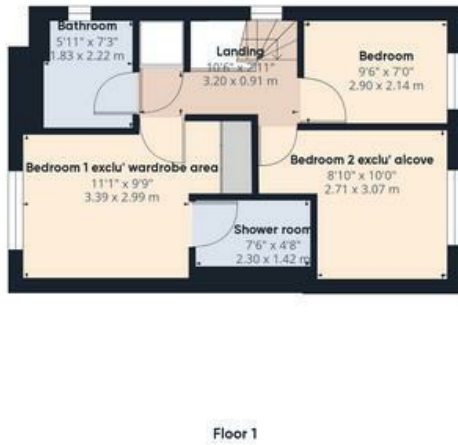

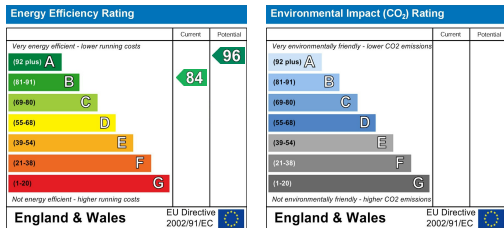
Area Map
