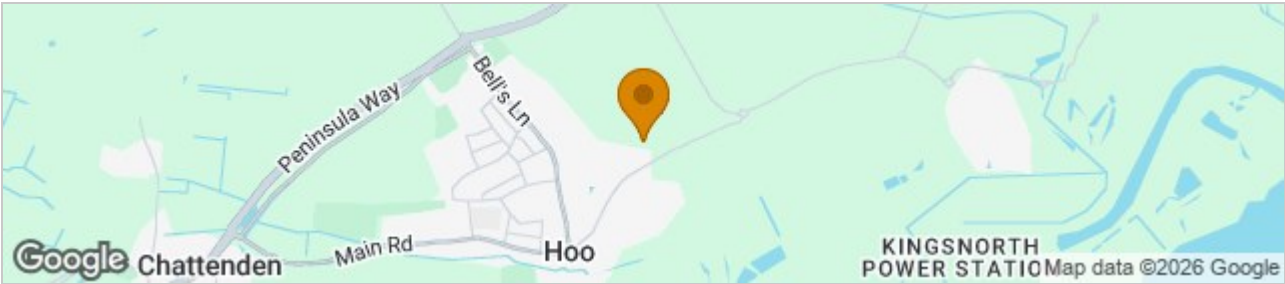

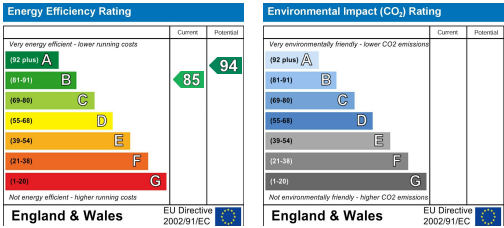
Area Map
