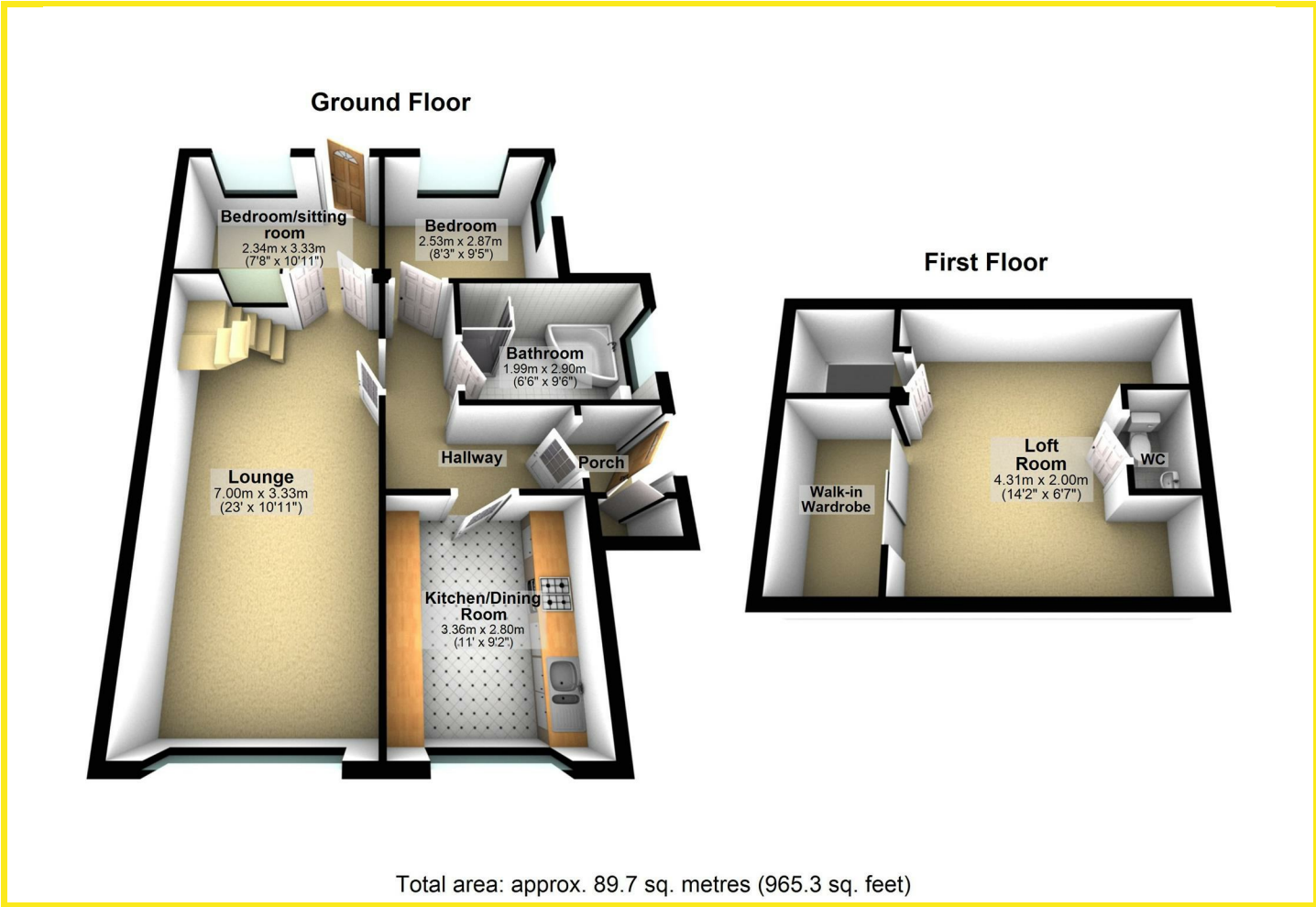

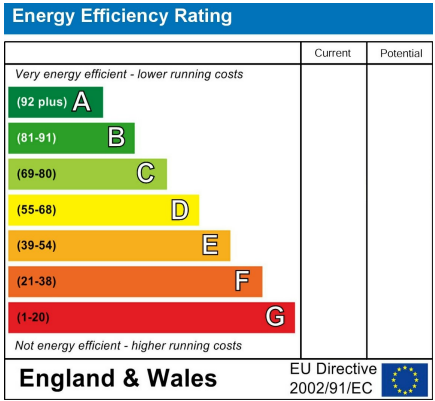
Floor Plan
