Surrounded by open farmland and beautiful views, the property enjoys a tranquil setting while remaining easily accessible to Jedburgh and Kelso, making it ideal for those seeking rural life without isolation.

Beautifully presented throughout in a country-chic style, the interiors feel warm, welcoming and comfortable, perfectly complementing the character of the cottage and its natural surroundings. At the same time, there remains scope for a purchaser to personalise and make their own mark if desired.

The accommodation is well laid out and comprises an entrance hall, a cosy lounge, a breakfasting kitchen with space for dining, and a bright conservatory overlooking the garden. The principal bedroom is particularly generous and benefits from excellent storage, including a large walk-in wardrobe and a useful box room accessed directly from the bedroom, offering flexibility for a home office, dressing room or additional storage. A second bedroom and well-appointed shower room complete the internal accommodation.

Externally, the property benefits from private parking to the front with driveway and woodstore. To the rear, an enclosed garden laid to lawn provides a lovely, manageable outdoor space in which to relax and enjoy the surrounding countryside. Full double glazing and LPG heating ensure comfort and efficiency throughout the year.

LOCATION

Eckford is a small village with a population of approximately 45 nestling in the foothills of the Cheviots, lying midway between Kelso and Jedburgh some 6 miles distant.

The nearby village of Morebattle has a primary school, general store, butchers, post office, hotel/pub and The Teviot Water Gardens and Smokery is nearby. Kelso, one of the most attractive and unspoiled towns in the Borders offers good educational and sporting facilities and many quality shops. Activities available locally include hill walking, fishing and golf at the championship standard course at The Roxburgh. An excellent location for walking and quiet country pursuits with wooded hills behind and the nearby Bowmont Forest providing ample scope for woodland walks.
