Ideally positioned above the charming cobbled square overlooking the vibrant town below with riverside walks quite literally on the doorstep, 26 The Square makes an excellent choice as a spacious yet easily maintained home - perfect as a holiday or second home, with excellent scope as a downsizer property.

Sitting on the characterful market square, the property is accessed from a private main door; opening to a traditional entrance hall with wood panelled walls and a stair to the far end. On the split landing, a comfortable double bedroom, with the main living space positioned on the first floor. A well-appointed kitchen sits to the rear; with an excellent range of fitted units and counter space, a breakfasting bar as well as adequate space for dining furnishings. To the front, the living room enjoys a glorious aspect overlooking the town, with a dual aspect providing wonderful natural light to the generously proportioned room, finished with fitted carpeting and feature fireplace. A neighbouring utility room provides useful storage, with the benefit of a cloakroom W/C.

Upstairs, two further double bedrooms are positioned to the front of the property, benefiting the excellent town outlook and allowing plenty of space for freestanding furnishings, with the family bathroom across the hall. In terms of popularity,

Kelso is among the front runners for those seeking a balance between country pursuits and amenities catering for modern requirement – this easily kept and lockup-and-leave apartment would make an excellent investment as a holiday or rental, with access to a range of lifestyle, work and leisure facilities.

## LOCATION

Kelso, which lies at the meeting point of the Tweed and Teviot rivers, is one of the most attractive and unspoiled towns in the Borders. Notable features are the 12th Century Abbey, the Flemish style cobbled square, Floors Castle and the old bridge across the Tweed. The town has good educational and sporting facilities and many quality shops. The area has much to offer those interested in country pursuits with fishing on the Tweed and is an increasingly sought after location within the Borders.
