Description

This well presented mid-terrace cottage enjoys glorious views over the surrounding countryside, sitting within a row of period homes in this sought after rural hamlet on the fringes of Chiddingstone. This charming property has been sympathetically extended to the rear and is presented in lovely order throughout whilst retaining period character. The gardens are a particular feature, being an excellent size and adjoining open countryside.

Accommodation

- The property is approached via a wooden gate and brick pathway leading to the solid wood stable front door, with lawn, cottage lavender borders and a mature hedging. Small log store.
- Entering the property into the delightful sitting room with exposed brick fireplace and wood burning stove, base cupboard to recess, central exposed beam, wooden flooring and Georgian style window with aspect to front. Staircase rising to the first floor with fitted seating area and understairs storage.
- Kitchen/dining room fitted with a range of Shaker style wall mounted cabinets and base units of cupboards and doors, including a peninsular breakfast bar incorporating an oven and gas hob, pretty tiled splashbacks and wooden block worktops. Ceramic sink and space for appliances including a washing machine, large fridge/freezer and slimline dishwasher; cupboard housing LPG gas boiler, ceramic tiled flooring and trap door to a wine cellar. Dining extension with a glass roof and French doors leading out to the garden with picturesque countryside views beyond.
- On the first floor, the principal bedroom to the front has a large Georgian style window and fitted wardrobes whilst to the rear is the second bedroom with two pretty windows overlooking the wonderful countryside. The family bathroom is full of character with sloping ceiling angles, a roll top slipper bath and a shower cubicle.
- Stairs from the landing lead to the second floor versatile attic room used as a study with windows to the rear and eaves storage cupboards.
- A delightful feature, the pretty cottage rear garden features a paved terrace ideal for entertaining leading onto a large L-shaped lawned area with mature trees and hedging and post and rail fencing, this wraps around the other cottages and enjoys a lovely open aspect over the countryside beyond.
- A pathway through the garden offers a pedestrian access to the generously sized garage in a nearby block with double doors and pitched roof. This block is located at the end of the row of cottages and is accessed from the road via a gravel driveway. The garage for number three is the third along.



- Services & Points of Note: Mains water and electricity. Calor gas heating, LPG storage tank located next to the garages. Shared cesspit drainage for the 6 cottages, managed by No.1.
- Council Tax: D – Sevenoaks District Council.

Situation
3 Bourne Row is situated within the High Weald Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty close to the historic National Trust village of Chiddingstone providing a sought after Church of England Primary school, Tulip Tree tea rooms, village shop, St Mary the Virgin Church and historic Chiddingstone Castle, as well The Castle Inn, serving locally brewed beer.

Nearby Chiddingstone Causeway also provides local amenities including a shop and Post Office, church, village hall, the popular Little Brown Jug Public House and Penshurst Railway Station (Tonbridge/Redhill Line).

The larger towns of Edenbridge, Sevenoaks, Tonbridge and Tunbridge Wells all provide a broader range of amenities, including shops and restaurants. Commuter train services can be accessed at Hildenborough, Sevenoaks and Tonbridge for services to London Charing Cross/Canon Street and Edenbridge for services on the Victoria Line. Conveniently, the A21 and M25 are easily accessible, offering routes to Gatwick and Heathrow Airports, Channel Tunnel and Bluewater shopping centre.

Well regarded schools include Chiddingstone, Four Elms and Leigh primary schools. Grammar schools for both boys and girls in Tonbridge and Tunbridge Wells with annexes in Sevenoaks. Tonbridge and Sevenoaks Public Schools and several Preparatory Schools.

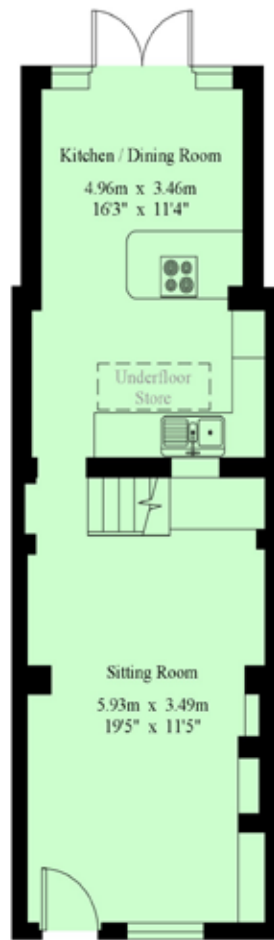

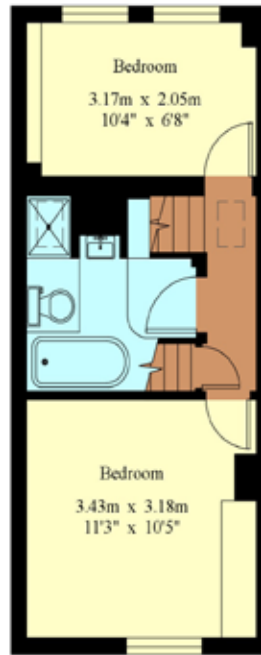

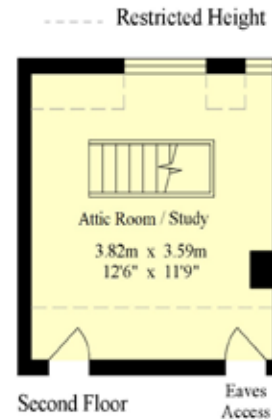
Ground Floor
