
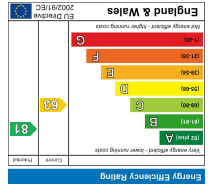
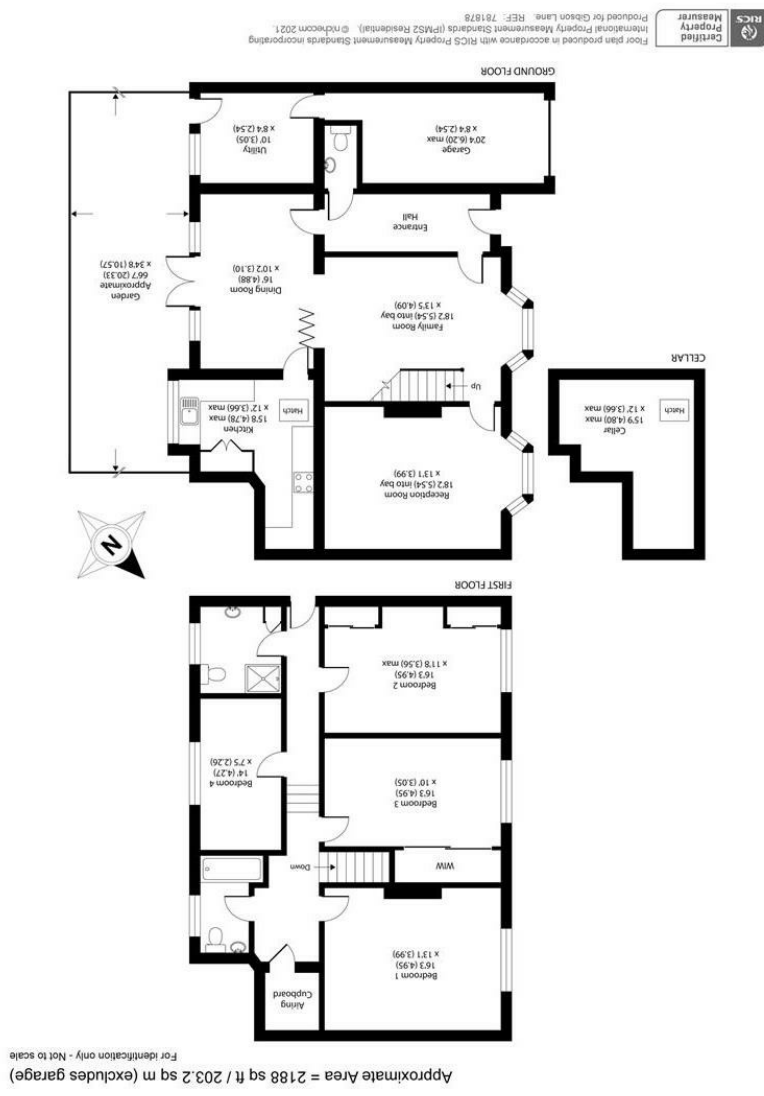

The accommodation arranged over two floors is in excess of 2100 sq ft and internally, the ground floor comprises of generous entrance hall (with downstairs WC), leading onto a large reception room with tall ceilings and large bay window with a staircase leading to the upper floor. Next to this is an additional reception room with stunning working fireplace and additional bay window and plenty of original features. To the rear of the property is a dining room and fully fitted kitchen and cellar with patio doors leading onto a delightfully landscaped private 66 ft rear garden. From the garden there is access to a utility room with new boiler and internal garage. To the upper floor there are four double bedrooms, family bathroom and shower room. Externally there is the added bonus of off street parking to the front for several cars. Viewings are highly recommended to appreciate what this fabulous home has to offer!!
