



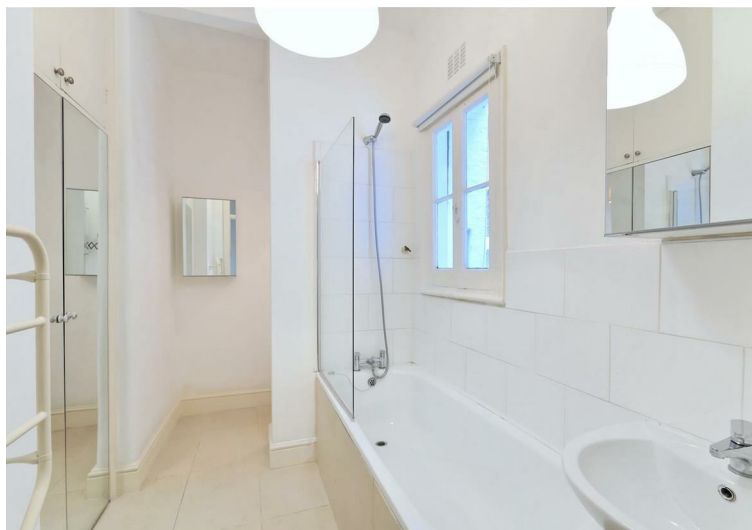
## Maida Avenue, Little Venice W2 £875,000 Subject to contract

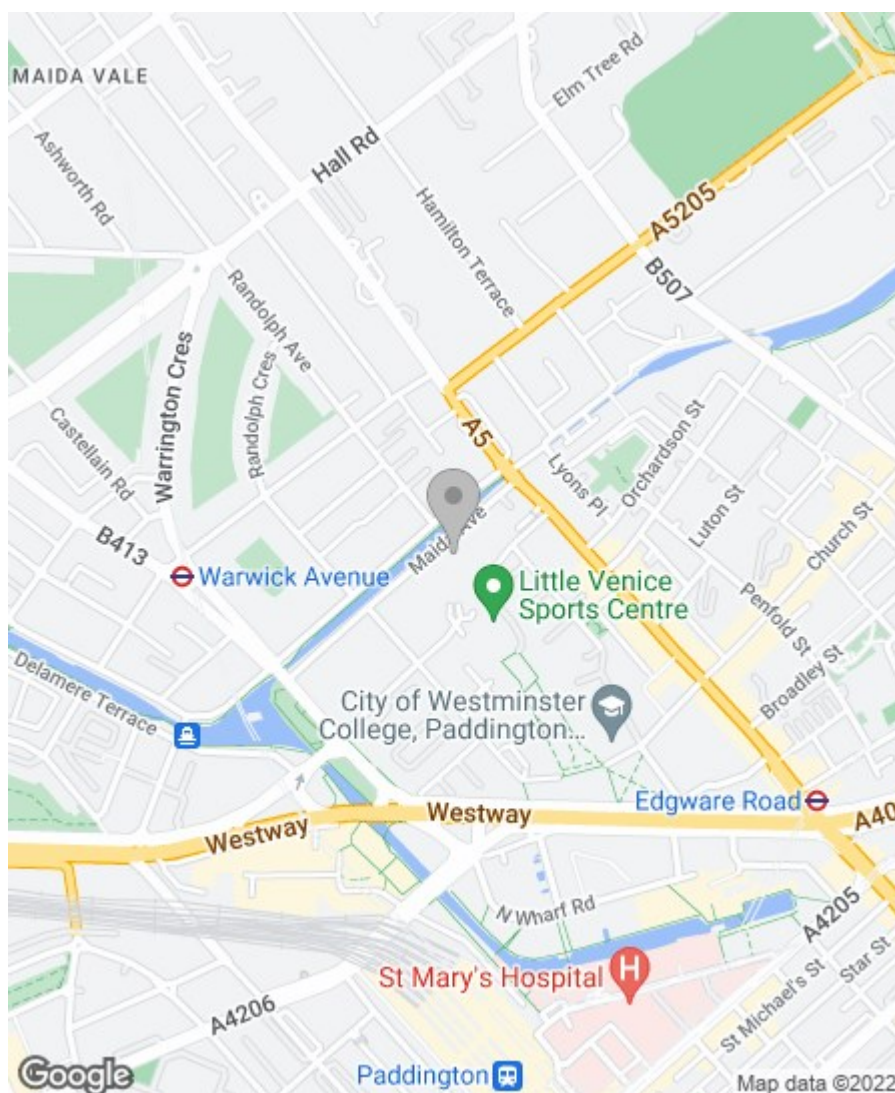
