A commodious detached 3 bedroom

bungalow with garage and large garden.

Ynyswen is well situated in the heart of the village within level walking distance of all local amenities which include post office, general stores/ garage, primary school and public house. The market town of Aberystwyth is some 9 miles travelling distance to the north and the Georgian harbour town of Aberaeron is a similar distance to the south. There is a regular bus service to both aforementioned towns together with a good range of amenities.

Ynyswen has been extended (see floor plan) and the existing attached garage can be converted to further accommodation subject to the necessary consents being obtained. The bungalow is double glazed and benefits from oil fired central heating and has been well looked after by the vendors.

The bungalow is within level walking distance of all amenities that are available at the village which include post office, garage/ general stores, public house & primary school. There is a regular bus service to the Georgian harbour town of Aberaeron which is some 7 miles travelling distance to the south and the university and market town of Aberystwyth which is some 9 miles or so to the north.

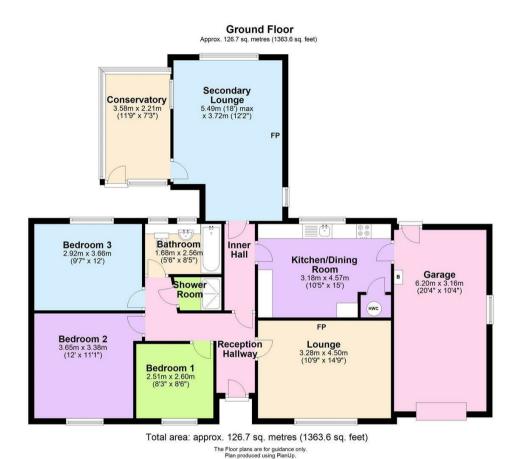
