Road Map



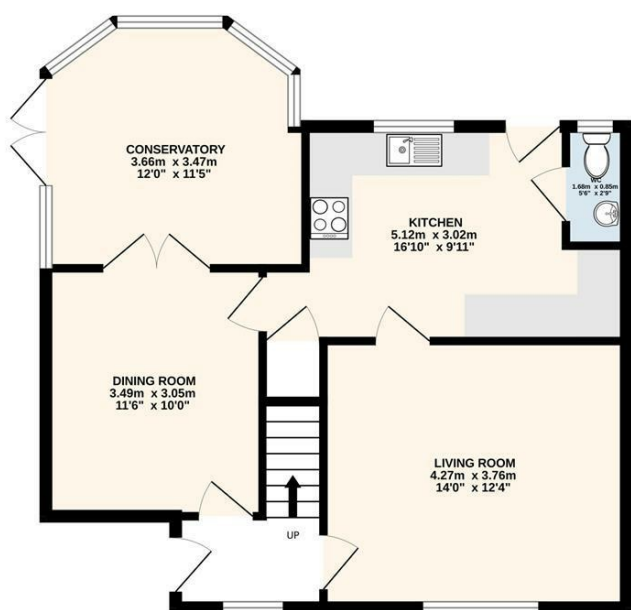
Hybrid Map
