Hybrid Map



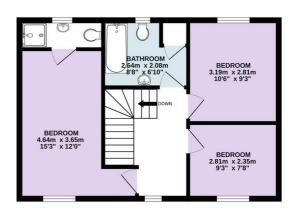
Terrain Map
