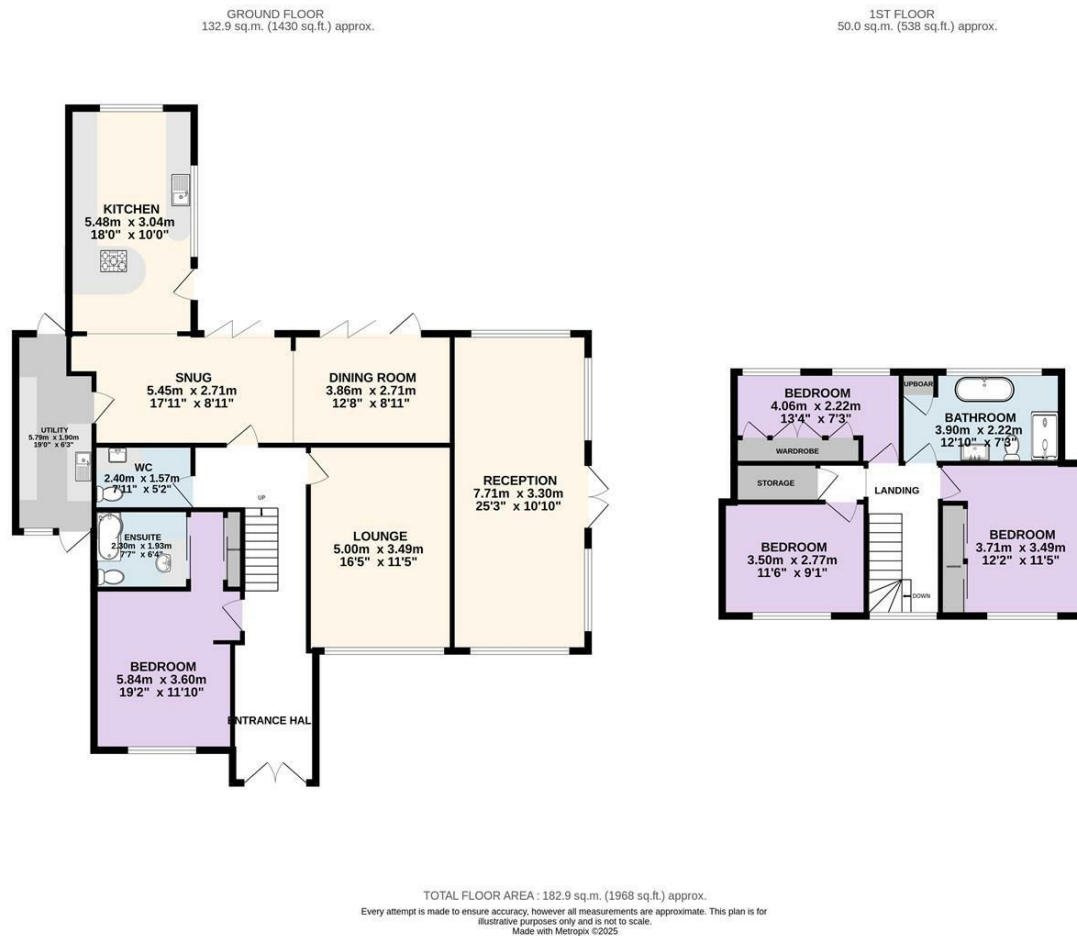
Road Map
