There is ample off road parking facilities which leads onto the generous garden space currently laid mainly to lawn with mature fruit trees. Surrounded by stone walling there are stunning sea views over Cardigan Bay from the top of the garden - the perfect place to dine alfresco or star gaze over the winter months.

LOCATION

The property is located in the village of Dyffryn Ardudwy - a coastal village located on the western fringe of the Snowdonia National Park. The area is well known for its sandy beaches and beautiful sunsets and is popular with visitors seeking relaxation, beautiful walks and stunning vistas. It has good local amenities including a post office, school, village hall, shops, cafes, petrol station and art gallery. It has regular bus services and a railway station with links to the local towns of Barmouth and Porthmadog, and extending to the Midlands and beyond.

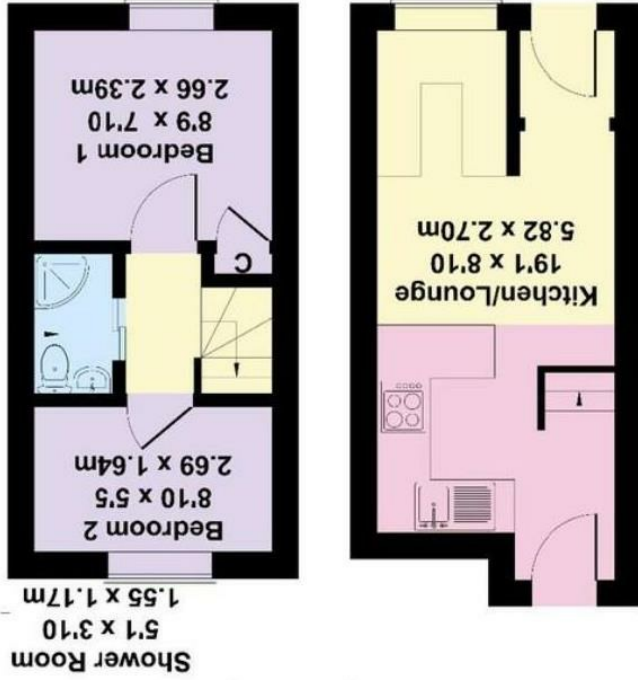

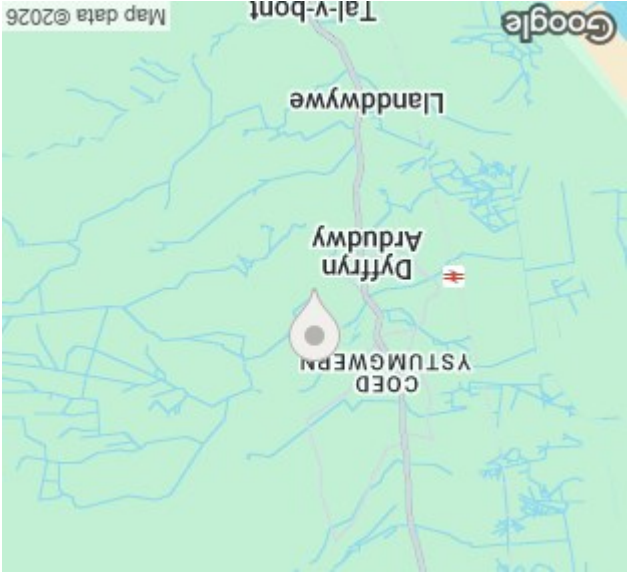
