#### **GROUND FLOOR**

#### **Entrance Hall**

with cloak area and quarry tiled floor with steps to crogloft (bedroom 1).

#### **Sitting Room**

with log burning stove, quarry tiled floor and feature exposed beams.

#### Kitchen/Breakfast Room

with a range of built in units with solid wood worktops, ceramic sink and drainer, Rayburn, crog loft storage and quarry tiled floors.

#### **Dining Room**

with log burner set in inglenook, quarry tiled floors and stable door leading to rear patio.

## **Rear Hallway**

with quarry tiled floors.

#### **Bedroom 2**

with carpet flooring, dual aspect windows and night storage heater.

#### **Bathroom**

with large shower cubicle, pedestal wash basin & low level WC; electric wall heater and guarry tiled floor.

Stained floor boards and rooflight.

The property is accessed via a country lane that leads to a parking area at the side of the property. There is a seating area with decking to the front; small patio and banked lawn to the side of the dining room and a small garden to the rear.

There is also a large stone/timber workshop (8.6m x 4.7m), a log store and a timber shed for the storage of the water borehole apparatus.

Mains electricity; oil fired Rayburn providing hot water; electric storage heaters and log burners; private drainage and private water supply via newly installed borehole.
