

- It's a pleasant wander into the city via Brick Lane and Shoreditch. On the way stop off for some bagels at Beigel Bake, visit the Spitalfields City Farm or spot Gilbert and George at their gallery on Heneage Street. There's so much choice.
- Moving in meal? Tayyabs is one of East London's most iconic restaurants, famed for its atmosphere and consistently regarded Punjabi cuisine. A Whitechapel institution since the 1970s, it's particularly known for its sizzling lamb chops. A true local favourite and destination spot alike.




