

You're in a great spot here with some of Walthamstow's best attractions within walking distance. Aside from Lloyd Park you're a seven minutes walk from the recently developed Fellowship Square, which hosts a thriving programme of events all year round; from winter markets to celebrations honouring the rich mix of cultures within the Borough this space really comes to life in the summer when the fountains are on. If you need to commute you've got plenty of bus routes to choose from, hop on the 97, 357, 34 or 215 and you can be at Walthamstow central in around ten minutes. From here it's just twenty minutes direct to Oxford Circus and Liverpool Street.

Back inside your new home, you'll be pleased by the sense of light and space thanks in part to the wooden flooring that bounces the light around. Your primary bedroom sits at the front of the property, and is exceptionally bright and airy. You'll love the two windows allowing the light to flood in here, with plenty of space for a king size bed, you benefit from high ceilings throughout the

apartment. The kitchen was recently updated and is stylish, with appliances including oven, fridge and, crucially, boiler; it features a chic checkerboard floor and plenty of cupboard space, with grey cabinets and contrast white countertops, it's a great space for cooking up your favourite food. - Take a wander down Hoe St, stopping off at Ye Old Rose and Crown, a theatre pub that hosts regular comedy nights from some of the best talent on the comedy scene.
- We recommend heading to local favourite Buhler & Co, sure to be your new local for grabbing a coffee and freshly baked cinnamon bun, they also have an extensive vegan and vegetarian brunch menu.
- If getting or staying fit is on the agenda, you'll be pleased to know that the Waltham Forest Feel Good Centre is a very short stroll (so you won't get much exercise getting there), where you'll find a gym with a 400m running track and 25m fitness pool with separate diving pit and teaching pool.
