


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
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IF YOU LIVED HERE...

An elegant Victorian profile sets the tone, with decorative mouldings, sash windows, and a tiled pathway guiding you to the front door. Warm-toned brickwork is offset by crisp white detailing, blending classic character with enduring appeal. Inside, the hallway leads to a bright landing, where timber floorboards and natural wood balustrades add texture, and a high-set window draws in daylight. At the front, the reception room impresses with its generous proportions, refined details, and inviting atmosphere. A striking bay window frames green views, while a side window enhances the sense of space. A decorative fireplace with intricate tiling serves as a focal point, complemented by herringbone flooring and a discreet built-in cupboard. The bedroom offers a calm retreat, with a wide sash window, verdant outlooks, and warm-toned flooring that pairs beautifully with soft neutral walls. A built-in wardrobe keeps the room uncluttered and versatile for rest or work. The bathroom is finished in neutral tones, with tiling adding texture and warmth. A fitted bath with overhead shower provides flexibility for both quick rinses and long soaks, while a frosted window allows daylight to filter through in privacy. At the rear, the kitchen/diner is bathed in sunshine from a large sash window and glazed door, opening to the south-facing garden. Pale cabinetry, metro tiling, and herringbone flooring create a harmonious backdrop for everyday living and entertaining. Outside, the garden provides a spacious, low-maintenance setting for seating and dining, basking in sunlight throughout the day.

Set within a vibrant pocket of East London, this location offers a lively mix of independent cafés, eateries, and green space. The nearby Railway Arches are home to artisan spots such as Joyau, bringing a creative buzz to the area, while Forest Gate Village offers a welcoming community feel. Ramble Café serves up expertly crafted coffee in relaxed surroundings, and Wild Goose Bakery tempts with freshly baked treats. Giovanna's Deli and Wine is a favourite for fine produce and a well-chosen bottle, while Forest Tavern provides a characterful setting for a drink with friends. For outdoor escapes, the wide, open expanse of Wanstead Flats, the southern tip of Epping Forest, offers sweeping grassland, walking trails, and a backdrop for running, cycling, or picnics.

WHAT ELSE?

Manor Park and Forest Gate stations are both under fifteen minutes away, with services to Liverpool Street making the City easily accessible. Even closer, Wanstead Park station is around ten minutes on foot, offering direct Overground links to Gospel Oak, Hampstead Heath, and Highbury & Islington. Together, they make commuting and exploring London effortless.
